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THE AERATED WATERS INDUSTRY, 1943.

Manufacturers of carbonated beverages in Canada reported a slight decrease of \$10,743 in the value of products in 1943 as compared with 1942. Output from these factories in 1943 was worth \$41,013,775 at factory selling prices compared with \$41,024,518 in 1942.

In 1943 there were 455 plants in Canada which were engaged chiefly in making non-alcoholic carbonated beverages. Of these, 153 were in Ontario, 161 in Quebec, 32 in Nova Scotia, 28 in British Columbia, 18 in New Brunswick, 20 in Saskatchewan, 20 in Manitoba, 19 in Alberta, and 4 in Prince Edward Island. Plants in Quebec and Ontario accounted for almost 75 per cent of the total production and over 75 per cent of the employees. In addition, 9 breweries made carbonated beverages as secondary products; 5 of these were in Ontario, 1 in Manitoba, 2 in Alberta and 1 in British Columbia.

Capital employed in the industry was reported at \$23,593,578 including \$14,717,425 as the value of lands, buildings and equipment, \$4,119,465 as the value of materials, stocks in process and finished products on hand, and \$4,756,688 as operating capital.

Employees numbered 5,584 including 1,488 on salaries and 4,096 on wages. Salaries amounted to \$2,956,464 and wages to \$5,304,958. Compared with the previous year there was a drop of 198 in the number of persons employed, but an increase of \$354,127 in the amount of salaries and wages paid. Average annual salaries at \$1,987 were \$109 higher while average annual wages at \$1,295 were \$97 higher. The number of females employed increased by 289 while the number of males decreased by 487, making a net decrease of 198 employees.

Production included carbonated beverages worth \$35,969,146 at the works, syrups, concentrates and extracts at \$4,569,163, natural mineral waters at \$117,214 and miscellaneous products at \$358,252. For details see table 3.

In addition to the production of carbonated beverages in this industry, there was an output worth \$816,176 by firms in the Brewing industry. Thus the total Canadian output of carbonated beverages amounted to \$36,785,322. For details see tables 4 and 5.

Materials used in 1943 were valued at \$13,742,105. Of this amount \$5,475,506 was spent for syrups, concentrates and flavours, \$4,835,652 for 68,323,895 pounds of sugar, \$2,075,211 for corks, caps, boxes and labels, \$614,426 for carbon dioxide gas, etc. The quantity of sugar used declined by 2,663,180 pounds or 3.7 per cent as compared with the previous year.
