THE AERATED WATERS INDUSTRY, 1945

Manufacturers of carbonated beverages in Canada reported a marked decrease of \$6,175,863 in the value of products in 1945 as compared with 1944. Output from these factories in 1945 was worth \$41,017,850 at factory selling prices not including sales and excise taxes, compared with \$47,193,713 in 1944.

In 1945 there were 453 plants in Canada which were engaged chiefly in making non-alcoholic carbonated beverages. Of these, 4 were in Prince Edward Island, 29 in Nova Scotia, 17 in New Brunswick, 163 in Quebec, 156 in Ontario, 19 in Manitoba, 20 in Saskatchewan, 18 in Alberta and 27 in British Columbia. Plants in Quebec and Ontario accounted for over 74 per cent of the total production and over 74 per cent of the employees. In addition, 9 breweries made carbonated beverages as secondary products; 5 of these were in Ontario, 1 in Manitoba, 2 in Alberta and 1 in British Columbia.

Employees numbered 5,473 including 1,481 on salaries and 3,992 on wages. Salaries amounted to \$3,217,157 and wages to \$5,454,940. Compared with the previous year there was a decrease of 326 in the number of persons employed, with a decrease of \$304,149 in the amount of salaries and wages paid. Average annual salaries at \$2,172 were \$55 higher while average annual wages at \$1,366 were \$15 higher. The number of females employed decreased by 141, while the number of males also decreased by 185, making a net decrease of 326 employees.

Production included carbonated beverages worth \$33,995,553 at the works, syrups, concentrates and extracts at \$6,589,791, natural mineral waters at \$166,453 and miscellaneous products at \$466,053. For details see table 3.

In addition to the production of carbonated beverages in this industry, there was an output worth \$602,000 by firms in the Brewing industry. Thus the total Canadian output of carbonated beverages in 1945 amounted to 51,335,353 gallons valued at \$34,597,553 as compared with an output of 64,226,063 gallons valued at \$40,738,177 in 1944. For details see tables 4 and 5.

Materials used in 1945 were valued at \$13,645,081. Of this amount \$5,591,591 was spent for syrups, concentrates and flavours, \$4,140,260 for 57,195,304 pounds of sugar, \$2,041,311 for corks, crowns, caps, boxes and labels, \$504,679 for carbon dioxide gas, etc. The quantity of sugar used decreased by 18,331,131 pounds in 1945.
