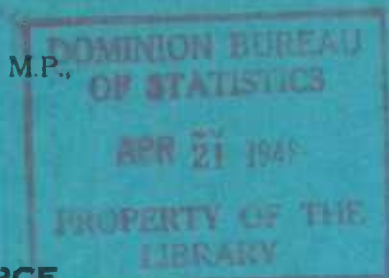

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THE AERATED WATERS INDUSTRY, 1946

Manufacturers of carbonated beverages in Canada reported an increase of \$2,030,830 in the value of products in 1946 as compared with 1945. Output from these factories in 1946 was worth \$43,048,680 at factory selling prices not including sales and excise taxes, compared with \$41,017,850 in 1945.

In 1946 there were 456 plants in Canada which were engaged chiefly in making non-alcoholic carbonated beverages. Of these, 4 were in Prince Edward Island, 29 in Nova Scotia, 18 in New Brunswick, 165 in Quebec, 154 in Ontario, 21 in Manitoba, 19 in Saskatchewan, 18 in Alberta and 28 in British Columbia. Plants in Quebec and Ontario accounted for 75 per cent of the total production and 76 per cent of the employees. In addition, 9 breweries made carbonated beverages as secondary products; 5 of these were in Ontario, 1 in Manitoba, 2 in Alberta and 1 in British Columbia.

Employees numbered 5,040 including 1,411 on salaries and 3,629 on wages. Salaries amounted to \$3,230,147 and wages to \$4,920,611. Compared with the previous year there was a decrease of 433 in the number of persons employed, with a decrease of \$521,339 in the amount of salaries and wages paid. Actually, there was an increase in employment during the year. The apparent decline is due to the change in the instructions for reporting factory employment. Formerly all persons employed at a plant were reported as being employed in manufacturing. In 1946 employers were required to report separately the wages paid to employees engaged in the retail or wholesale end of their business. If the amount thus paid in 1946, amounting to \$1,085,899 were added to the \$8,150,758 in salaries and wages paid to production employees, an increase of \$564,560 is shown for the year. Average annual salaries at \$2,289 were \$117 higher while average annual wages at \$1,356 were \$10 lower. The number of females employed decreased by 295, while the number of males decreased by 138, making a total decrease of 433 employees.

Production included carbonated beverages worth \$36,408,366 at the works, syrups, concentrates and extracts at \$6,162,226 natural mineral waters at \$124,970 and miscellaneous products at \$353,118. For details see table 3.

In addition to the production of carbonated beverages in this industry, there was an output worth \$648,847 by firms in the Brewing industry. Thus the total Canadian output of carbonated beverages in 1946 amounted to 55,728,736 gallons valued at \$37,057,213 as compared with an output of 51,335,353 gallons valued at \$34,597,553 in 1945. For details see tables 3 and 4.

Materials used in 1946 were valued at \$14,872,546. Of this amount \$6,270,368 was spent for syrups, concentrates and flavours, \$4,244,219 for 58,364,728 pounds of sugar, \$2,333,727 for corks, crowns, caps, boxes and labels, \$516,161 for carbon dioxide gas, etc. The quantity of sugar used increased by 1,169,424 pounds in 1946.
