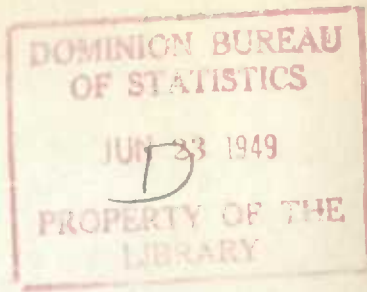

THE AERATED WATERS INDUSTRY, 1947

Manufacturers of carbonated beverages in Canada reported an increase of \$12,833,514 in the value of products in 1947 as compared with 1946. Output from these factories in 1947 was worth \$55,882,194 at factory selling prices not including sales and excise taxes, compared with \$43,048,680 in 1946.

In 1947 there were 456 plants in Canada which were engaged chiefly in making carbonated beverages. Of these, 5 were in Prince Edward Island, 28 in Nova Scotia, 18 in New Brunswick, 163 in Quebec, 155 in Ontario, 22 in Manitoba, 19 in Saskatchewan, 18 in Alberta, 27 in British Columbia and 1 in the Yukon. Plants in Quebec and Ontario accounted for 77 per cent of the total production and 76 per cent of the employees. In addition, 9 breweries made carbonated beverages as secondary products; 5 of these were in Ontario, 1 in Manitoba, 2 in Alberta and 1 in British Columbia

These 456 establishments furnished employment to 5,827 persons who were paid \$9,502,452 in salaries and wages. They also spent \$20,248,739 for materials and produced goods that had a selling value at the factory of \$55,882,194

With the removal of the restrictions on the consumption of sugar the industry experienced a sharp rise in production. The volume of aerated waters increased about 25 per cent as compared with the previous year. This expanded output is also reflected in the increase of 787 in the number of persons employed and \$1,351,694 in the salaries and wages paid. Average annual salaries at \$2,396 were \$107 higher, while average annual wages at \$1,374 were only \$18 higher.

Production included carbonated beverages worth \$47,164,458 at the works, syrups, concentrates and extracts at \$8,374,875, natural mineral waters at \$94,526, and miscellaneous products at \$248,335. For details see table 3.

In addition to the production of carbonated beverages in this industry, there was an output worth \$951,459 by firms in the Brewing industry. Thus the total Canadian output of carbonated beverages in 1947 amounted to 69,413,261 gallons valued at \$48,115,917 as compared with an output of 55,728,736 gallons valued at \$37,057,213 in 1946. For details see tables 3 and 4.

Materials used in 1947 were valued at \$20,248,739. Of this amount \$8,301,709 was spent for syrups, concentrates and flavours, \$6,536,633 for 77,994,277 pounds of sugar, \$3,174,786 for corks, crowns, caps, boxes and labels, \$39,217 for carbon dioxide gas, etc. The quantity of sugar used increased by 19,629,549 pounds in 1947.
