## THE AERATED WATERS INDUSTRY, 1948.

Manufacturers of carbonated beverages in Canada reported an increase of \$11,165,531 in the value of products in 1948 as compared with 1947. Output from these factories in 1948 was worth \$67,047,725 at factory selling prices not including sales and excise taxes, compared with \$55,882,194 in 1947.

In 1948 there were 458 plants in Canada which were engaged chiefly in making carbonated beverages. Of these, 5 were in Prince Edward Island, 28 in Nova Scotia, 17 in New Brunswick, 164 in Quebec, 155 in Ontario, 21 in Manitoba, 20 in Saskatchewan, 18 in Alberta, 29 in British Columbia and 1 in the Yukon. Plants in Quebec and Ontario accounted for 75 per cent of the total production and 74 per cent of the employees. In addition, 9 breweries made carbonated beverages as secondary products; 5 of these were in Ontario, 1 in Manitoba, 2 in Alberta and 1 in British Columbia.

These 458 establishments furnished employment to 6,683 persons who were paid \$12,014,843 in salaries and wages. They also spent \$24,809,777 for materials and produced goods that had a selling value at the factory of \$67,047,725.

The rise in production experienced by this industry since the removal of restrictions on the consumption of sugar continued in 1948. There was thus a further increase of 23 per cent in the volume of aerated waters produced, this on top of an increase of 25 per cent in the previous year. The expanded output in 1948 is also reflected in an increase of 856 in the number of persons employed and \$2,512,391 in the salaries and wages paid. Average annual salaries at \$2,519 with \$123. higher while average annual wages at \$1,576 were \$202. higher.

Production included carbonated beverages worth \$56,401,498 at the works, syrups, concentrates and extracts at \$10,329,664, natural mineral waters at \$96,497 and miscellaneous products at \$220,064. For details see table 3.

In addition to the production of carbonated beverages in this industry, there was an output worth \$947,530 by firms in the Brewing industry. Thus the total Canadian output of carbonated beverages in 1948 amounted to 85,668,714 gallons valued at \$57,349,028 as compared with an output of 69,413,261 gallons valued at \$48,115,917 in 1947. For details see tables 3 and 4.

Materials used in 1948 were valued at \$24,809,777. Of this amount \$9,774,072 was spent for syrups, concentrates and flavours, \$8,218,713 for 95,972,821 pounds of sugar, \$4,411,189 for corks, crowns, caps, boxes and labels, \$732,685 for carbon dioxide gas, etc. The quantity of sugar used increased by 17,978,544 pounds in 1948.
