

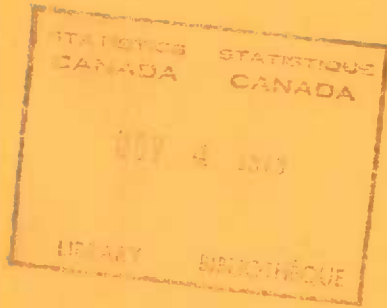

Principal statistics of establishments classified by size group, based on total employed, were omitted from industry reports for the years 1968-1971 and principal statistics of establishments by type of organization were last published in the 1967 industry reports. However, this information is available on request from the Manufacturing and Primary Industries Division. In the case of an extensive request, involving a large number of industries or years, it may be necessary to levy a charge.
3. Users interested in obtaining the value of production (manufacturing activity) can do so by adding cost of materials and supplies used (manufacturing activity), cost of fuel and electricity, and value added (manufacturing activity).

Definition of Industry

This industry includes establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing non-alcoholic beverages and carbonated mineral waters or concentrates and syrups for the manufacture of carbonated beverages.

Developments

In 1973 the industry had 337 establishments, for a net decrease of 26 establishments from the total of 363 establishments in 1972. Summary comparisons of selected factors between 1972 and 1973 show:

Commencing 1970 the small establishments were not required to report commodity details on inputs or outputs. In 1973 these establishments reported revenues of \$7.99 millions or 1.63% of the total revenue of own manufacture. In 1973, the average revenue per gallon was \$1.35. If the total revenues of the small establishments were converted to gallons, the additional volume would be about 5.9 million gallons. The revised reporting procedures affects commodity details in Tables 5 and 6.

Trends

In summary, between 1969 and 1973 selected ratios in manufacturing activity show the following trends:

Définition de l'industrie

Cette industrie comprend les établissements dont l'activité principale est la fabrication de boissons non-alcooliques et d'eaux minérales gazeuses ou de concentrés et de sirops destinés à la fabrication de boissons gazeuses.

Développements

En 1973, cette industrie comptait 337 établissements, il y a eu une diminution nette de 26 établissements contre le total de 363 établissements en 1972. Sous une forme résumée les tendances suivantes se dégagent de certaines données de 1972 et 1973:

Depuis 1970, les petits établissements ne sont pas tenus de fournir des renseignements sur leurs entrées ou leurs sorties. En 1973, les recettes totales de ces entreprises ont atteint \$7.99 millions, soit 1.63 % de la valeur totale des livraisons de produits de propre fabrication. En 1973, la recette moyenne par gallon était de \$1.35. Si les recettes totales de petits établissements étaient converties en gallons, le volume supplémentaire serait d'environ 5.9 millions de gallons. La nouvelle méthode de déclaration influe sur les détails des produits figurant aux tableaux 5 et 6.

Tendances

L'évolution de l'activité manufacturière entre 1969 et 1973 est donnée sous une forme résumée par les pourcentages ci-dessous:

EXPLANATORY NOTES

The following abbreviated notes deal only with salient points or selected inclusions or exclusions which might not be self-evident. Detailed "Concepts and Definitions" are available on request; see "Notes to Users".

Establishment – Smallest operating unit capable of reporting certain specified input and output data, usually a plant or mill.

Large Establishments

Cost of materials and supplies, fuel and electricity – Generally, consumption of purchased items only, at laid-down cost. Includes inter-company and intracompany transfers, contract work by others, fuel used by vehicles.

Value of shipments of goods of own manufacture – Goods made by reporting establishment, or for its account, from its own materials, net of discounts, returns, allowances, sales tax, excise taxes and duties, returnable containers, common or contract carriers' charges for outward transportation (but not of own carriers' delivery expense). Includes repair and custom revenue, transfers to reporting units of same firm, all exports, book value of own products shipped on rental basis. Unsold domestic consignment shipments are included in inventory. In fabricated structural metal industry, aircraft and aircraft parts manufacturers, railroad rolling stock industry and shipbuilding and repair, value of production is shown in place of shipments in tables on principal statistics. Integrated smelters' work on own ore valued at imputed charge to mine.

Value added – Net output as measured by gross output less purchased commodity inputs used and contract work by others.

(a) **Value added, manufacturing activity:** Value of shipments of goods of own manufacture plus net change in inventory of goods in process and finished goods, less cost of materials and supplies used, fuel and electricity.

(b) **Value added, total activity:** Consists of (1) value added, manufacturing activity and (2) value added, non-manufacturing activity. The latter is calculated by subtracting relevant commodity inputs from non-manufacturing revenues or outputs; these commodity inputs are net of the change in inventories of goods purchased for resale. Non-manufacturing revenues include depreciable fixed assets produced by own work force for own use, revenue from product rentals, etc., but exclude non-operating revenue such as real property rentals, dividends, interest.

Employees, salaries and wages – Salaries and wages are reported before deductions for income tax and employee benefits and comprise all man-hours paid (for regular work, overtime and paid leave) as well as bonuses, commissions, etc., paid to regular employees. Where shown, production and related workers classified to non-manufacturing activity include separately reported loggers, employees on construction for own use; beginning with the 1970 Census outside pieceworkers formerly included for certain industries are excluded from all employment totals and their remuneration treated as contract work done by others. Sales and distribution employees include all personnel charged to selling expense, certain drivers, etc.

Inventories – Book value of owned inventory held in Canada, including goods in transit and on consignment.

Small Establishments

For establishments filing "short forms", beginning with 1970 data, "cost of materials, supplies and services" includes all purchased services, and "total revenue excluding interest and dividends received" is used for both shipments of goods of own manufacture and gross output, total activity; value added is calculated using these figures and net change in total inventory, and is thus identical for manufacturing and total activity. Numbers of employees are imputed from reported salaries and wages.

Head offices, sales offices and auxiliary units – Included in the individual industry of the company's largest activity. (The allocation of some such units to the major industry group level was discontinued with the 1970 data).

NOTES EXPLICATIVES

Les notes succinctes ci-après s'arrêtent uniquement aux points saillants et à certaines extensions ou restrictions pouvant nécessiter une explication. Sur simple demande, on pourra obtenir les "Concepts et définitions" détaillés; se reporter aux "Notes au lecteur".

Établissement – Plus petite unité exploitante en mesure de fournir certaines données sur ses facteurs de production (entrées) et sur sa production (sorties); en général: usine ou fabrique.

Grands établissements

Coût des matières et fournitures, du combustible et de l'électricité – De manière générale, concerne uniquement la consommation de produits achetés, au prix franco. Comprend les transferts entre filiales et établissements d'une société, les travaux exécutés par d'autres aux termes d'un contrat et la consommation de carburant, par les véhicules.

Valeur des livraisons de produits de propre fabrication – Concerne les produits fabriqués par l'établissement enquêté, ou pour son compte, à partir de matières lui appartenant, déduction faite des rabais, des retours de marchandises, des remises, des taxes de ventes, des taxes et des droits d'accise, des emballages consignés, des frais de livraisons payés à des transporteurs publics ou sous contrat (mais non des frais de livraisons de l'établissement même). Comprend les recettes de réparations et de contrats, les transferts à d'autres unités enquêtées de la même firme, les exportations, la valeur comptable des produits donnés en location par l'établissement. Les livraisons sans vente en consignation au Canada sont prises en compte dans les stocks. En ce qui concerne l'industrie de la fabrication d'éléments de charpente métallique, les fabricants d'aéronefs et de pièces, les fabricants de matériel ferroviaire roulant ainsi que l'industrie de construction et réparation de navires, la valeur de la production remplace les livraisons dans les tableaux relatifs aux statistiques principales. Pour déterminer la valeur du travail effectué par une fonderie intégrée sur du minerai lui appartenant, on calcule le coût qu'il faudrait imputer à la mine.

Valeur ajoutée – Sortie nette, soit sortie brute moins consommation de biens achetés et travaux exécutés par d'autres sous contrat.

(a) **Valeur ajoutée, activité manufacturière:** valeur des livraisons de produits de propre fabrication, plus variation nette des stocks de produits en cours et de produits finis, moins coût des matières et des fournitures utilisées, du combustible et de l'électricité.

(b) **Valeur ajoutée, activité totale:** comprend (1) la valeur ajoutée par l'activité manufacturière et (2) la valeur ajoutée par l'activité non manufacturière. Cette dernière s'obtient en soustrayant les entrées de marchandises des recettes ou des sorties provenant de l'activité non manufacturière, après avoir soustrait de ces entrées la variation des stocks de produits achetés pour la revente. Les recettes provenant de l'activité non manufacturière comprennent les éléments d'actif amortissable produits par la main-d'oeuvre de l'établissement pour son usage propre, les recettes de location de produits, etc., mais non les recettes hors-exploitation, comme les loyers d'immeubles, les dividendes, les intérêts.

Salariés, traitements et salaires – Les traitements et salaires sont pris en compte avant les retenues au titre de l'impôt sur le revenu et des avantages sociaux des employés; ils comprennent les heures-hommes payées (heures normales, supplémentaires et congés payés) ainsi que les gratifications, commissions, etc. versées aux salariés. Les travailleurs de la production et assimilés classés dans l'activité non manufacturière comprennent les bûcherons, les ouvriers de la construction pour le compte de l'établissement, etc., lorsqu'ils ont été déclarés séparément; à partir du recensement de 1970, les ouvriers à la pièce de l'extérieur, autrefois classés dans certaines industries, ne sont plus compris dans la statistique de l'emploi et leur rémunération a été prise en compte au titre des travaux sous contrat exécutés par des tiers. Les employés à la vente et à la distribution comprennent tout le personnel imputé aux frais de vente, certains chauffeurs, etc.

Stocks – Valeur comptable des stocks détenus en toute propriété au Canada, y compris les marchandises en transit ou en consignation.

Petits établissements

Pour les établissements qui remplissent une "formule abrégée", le coût des matières, fournitures et services" comprend, à partir des données de 1970, tous les services achetés, et le "total des recettes, sauf sous forme d'intérêts et de dividendes" vaut à la fois pour les livraisons de marchandises de propre fabrication et pour la production brute de l'activité totale; la valeur ajoutée est calculée à partir de ces chiffres et de la variation nette des stocks et est donc identique pour l'activité manufacturière et pour l'activité totale. Le nombre de salariés est déterminé à partir des rémunérations déclarées.

Sièges sociaux, bureaux de vente et unités auxiliaires – Classés avec l'industrie qui représente l'activité principale de la société. (Le classement de certaines de ces unités au niveau des groupes a cessé à partir des données de 1970).
