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REPORT ON THE PRODUCTION OF PROCESSED CHEESE

IN CANADA, 1934

The production of processed cheese in Canada in 1934 amounted to 11.996.348 pounds, an increase over the preceding year of 1, 361, 324 pounds, or 13 per cent, and an increase over 1932 of 1,281,834 pounds, or 12 per cent. Processed cheese is made from ordinary cheddar cheese, the process consisting of grinding the cheese, heating it in a jacketed container, and then filling it into the proper receptacles f It is placed on the market in conveniently sized packages of one half pound or one quarter pound, and also in larger blocks to be sold in bulk. There was formerly a considerable export trade in this prepared cheese, but in 1934 the exports totalled only 739,962 pounds, or 6 per cent of the total quantity manufactured.


