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REPORT ON THE PROCESSED CHEESE INDUSTRY, CANADA, 1942.

The production of processed cheese in Canada in the year 1942 amounted to 26,822,200 pounds, valued at \$8,077,689, compared with 21,030,140 pounds, valued at \$5,226,260 in the preceding year. The quantity of cheddar cheese used by the industry in the preparation of the product was 20,258,387 pounds, compared with 15,545,422 pounds in 1941.

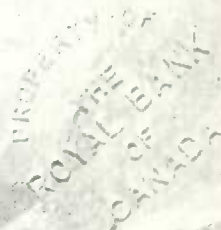
