REPORT ON THE PROCESSED CHEESE INDUSTRY, CANADA, 1945

The total value of the products of this industry amounted to \$19,249,001 in 1945, a decrease of 2.1 p.c., as compared with 1944. Production of processed cheese was 33,448,482 lb., a decrease of 1.6 p.c., as compared with 1944 and the value was \$9,850,077, or 3.6 p.c., under that for 1944. The quantity of cheddar cheese used by the industry was lower by 1 p.c., as compared with 1944.

The drying of egg powder accounted for \$4,207,292, or 44.8 p.c. of the value of other products. The value of sandwich spread, salad dressing, cheese of types other than processed or cheddar, and other products, rose from \$2,761,855 in 1944 to \$5,191,632 in 1945. Employment decreased by 11.3 p.c., but salary and wage payments dropped by only 3.6 p.c., presumably owing to a more stable labour situation and the laying-off of part-time workers, particularly in the egg-drying end of the industry.
