The total value of the production of the industry in 1949, at \$22,698,780, was the highest on record but the quantity of process cheese manufactured was 2.4 p.c. below the amount produced in 1948. Process cheese accounted for 61 p.c. of the total value, cream cheese for 6 p.c. and other products, including egg powder, sandwich spread and salad dressing, for 33 p.c. The total value of production was 5.0 p.c. over that of 1948 and 4.8 p.c. over that of 1947, the former peak year.
