THE PROCESS CHEESE INDUSTRY, 1953.

Price 10 cents

The value of shipments in the process cheese industry reached a high point of \$27,271,289 in 1953, an increase of 7 p.c. over the \$25,482,566 recorded for 1952. The cost of materials was \$21,733,959, an increase of 7 p.c. over the previous year. Employment was afforded to 1,170 persons, an increase of 11 p.c. while salary and wage payments, at \$3,063,957, were 9 p.c. above those paid in 1952.

Process cheese, the principal product, accounted for \$17,189,135 or 63 p.c. of the total value, cream cheese for \$1,452,540, or 5 p.c. and other products, including salad dressing, sandwich spread, margarine, etc., for \$8,629.614, or 32 p.c. of the total shipments.
