THE PROCESS CHEESE INDUSTRY, 1957

The process cheese industry shipped goods to the value of \$29,512,315 in 1957, an increase of 7.6 p.c. over the \$27,434,586 reported for 1956. The cost of materials, at \$23,876,372, was 8.9 p.c. higher than the \$21,931,375 shown in the previous year. Employment, at 1,103 persons, was 1 p.c. greater and salary and wage payments, at \$3,966,035, was 12.9 p.c. above the \$3,513,810 reported for 1956.

Process cheese was the principal product and accounted for 67.1 p.c. of the total value of shipments, or \$19,813,194 as against \$18,654,491 while the remaining 32.9 p.c. was made up of such products as cream cheese, salad dressing, sandwich spread and margarine. The value of shipments of these commodities was \$9,699,121 as compared with \$8,780,095 in 1956.
