THE PROCESS CHEESE INDUSTRY, 1958

The process cheese industry shipped goods to the value of \$34,834,242 in 1958, an increase of 18 p.c. over the \$29,512,315 reported for 1957. The cost of materials, at \$37,860,277 was 16.7 p.c. higher than \$23,876,372 shown in the previous year. Number of employees at 1,238 was 12 p.c. greater and salary and wages payments, at \$4,570,376 was 15.3 p.c. above the \$3,966,035 reported for 1957.

Process cheese was the principal product and accounted for 64.3 p.c. of the total value of shipments, or \$22,395,913 as against \$19,813,194 for 1957, while the remaining 35.7 p.c. was made up of such products as cream cheese, cottage cheese, salad dressing, sandwich spread and margarine. The value of shipments of these commodities was \$12,438,329 as compared with \$9,699,121 in 1957.
