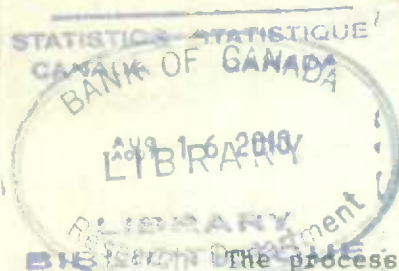

## THE PROCESS CHEESE INDUSTRY, 1959

The process cheese industry shipped goods to the value of \$34,599,820 in 1959, a decrease of .7 p.c. from the \$34,834,242 reported for 1958. The cost of materials, at \$27,339,503 was 1.9 p.c. lower than the \$27,860,277 shown in the preceding year. Number of employees at 1,084 was 12.4 p.c. fewer but salary and wage payments, at \$4,623,844 was 1.2 p.c. above the \$4,570,376 reported for 1958.

Process cheese was the principal product and accounted for 67.7 p.c. of the total value of shipments, or \$23,434,757 up 4.6 p.c. from the \$22,395,913 for 1958, while the remaining 32.3 p.c. was made up of such products as cream cheese, cottage cheese, salad dressing and sandwich spread. The value of shipments of these commodities was \$11,165,063, down 10.3 p.c. from the \$12,438,329 in 1958.
