QUARTERLY PRODUCTION OF GARMENTS

(Selected Items)


Second Quarter, 1952

The Dominion Bureau of Statistics publishes herewith a report on the current production of selected items in the secondary textile field for the first quarter of 1952. It is to be noted that all data are compiled on a commodity basis, irrespective of industrial classification, and that they are to be considered as preliminary and subject to revision.

In the second quarter of 1952, production of Men's and Youths' all Wool one-pant suits amounted to 255,123 as against 330,280 in the corresponding quarter of 1951. All wool two-pant suits totalled 60,651 compared to 60,183 in the second quarter of 1952. There were 16,179 Boys' all Wool one-pant suits manufactured in contrast to 25,351 reported for the same period in 1951.

Production of Men's and Youths' all Wool pants and slacks amounted to 234,280, a decrease compared to the second quarter of 1951, when 273,487 were manufactured. There were 135,950 dozen Men's and Youths' fine cotton shirts produced, as against 148,314 in the second quarter of 1951.

Output of Men's and Youths' fine nylon shirts was 5,136 dozen as against 2,720 dozen produced in the second quarter of the previous year.



There were 330,352 Womens' and Misses' Wool Coats made in the second quarter of 1952, compared to 264,407 in the same period last year. A decrease in the Manufacture of rayon and rayon mixtures dresses is noted, with 1,705,024 reported while the production in the second quarter of 1951 totalled 1,903,786.

Production of nylon dresses increased, with 87,248 reported, while the production of these garments during the second quarter of 1951 amounted to 36,451. The output of nylon blouses also increased. Production amounted to 38,727 dozen compared to 23,217; 8,162; 4,820 and 4,173 dozen manufactured in the fourth, third, second and first quarters of 1951, and 34,831 dozen in the first quarter of 1952.
