

## Third Quarter, 1952

In the third quarter of 1952 the production of Men's and Youths' one-pant suits showed a decrease when compared with the same quarter of the previous year. In the same period Women's and Misses' wool coats showed a slight increase and the output of nylon shirts and blouses showed large increases with shirts more than tripled.

Production of Men's and Youths' all wool one-pant suits amounted to 212,-110 compared to 239,308 in the corresponding quarter of 1951. All wool twopant suits totalled 55,151 as against 41,757 in the third quarter of 1951. Boys' all wool one-pant suits amounted to 12,550 in contrast to 13,001 produced in the same period in 1951.

In the third quarter of 1952, production of Men's and Youths' all wool pants and slacks totalled 241,541, while 312,682 of these garments were manufactured during the third quarter of 1951. The manufacture of 117,759 dozen Men's and Youths' fine cotton shirts was reported, as against 111,810 in the same quarter last year.



The output of Men's and Youths' fine nylon shirts was 8,495 dozen compared to 2,324 dozen produced in the third quarter of the previous year.

> There were 455,027 Women's and Misses' Wool Coats made in the third quarter of 1952 while production in the same period in 1951 was 401,344. Manufacture of rayon and rayon mixtures dresses totalled 1,671,105 while the production in the third quarter of 1951 amounted to 1,517,076.

Output of nylon blouses increased. with 55,649 dozen being reported, compared to 38,727 and 34,831 manufactured in the second and first quarters of 1952, and 8,162 in the third quarter of 1951.
