## Fourth Quarter, 1952


In the fourth quarter of 1952 the production of Men's and Youths' one-pant suits showed an increase when compared with the same quarter of the previous year. Women's and Misses' wool coats also showed an increase as did the production of nylon shirts and blouses.

Production of Men's and Youths' all wool one-pant suits amounted to 237,410 compared to 224,234 in the corresponding quarter of 1951. All wool two-pant suits totalled 60,800 as against 42,367 in the fourth quarter of 1951. Boys' all wool one-pant suits amounted to 12,098 in contrast to 12,223 produced in the same period in 1951.

In the fourth quarter of 1952 production of Men's and Youths' all wool pants and slacks totalled 190,397 while 267,826 of these garments were manufactured during the fourth quarter of 1951. The manufacture of 150,857 dozen Men's and Youths' fine cotton shirts was reported as a gainst 130,331 dozen in the same quarter last year.

The output of Men's and Youths' fine nylon shirts was 10,079 dozen com-

pared to 5,124 dozen produced in the fourth quarter of the previous year.



There were 330,840 Women's and Misses' wool coats made in the fourth quarter of 1952 while production in the same period in 1951 was 295,446. Manufacture of rayon and rayon mixtures dresses totalled 1,698,796 while the production in the fourth quarter of 1951 amounted to 1,436,356.

Output of nylon blouses again increased, with 58,356 dozen being reported compared to 55,649, 38,727 and 34,831 dozen manufactured in the third, second and first quarters of 1952, and 23,217 in the fourth quarter of 1951.
