

## QUARTERLY PRODUCTION OF GARMENTS



## First Quarter, 1953

In the first quarter of 1953 the production of Men's and Youths' one-pant suits showed a considerable increase compared with the same quarter of the previous year, and an increase was also evident in the production of Women's and Misses' wool coats.

Production of Men's and Youths' all-wool one-pant suits; amounted to 311,408 compared to 270,445 in the corresponding quarter of 1952. All wool two-pant suits totalled 92,206 as against 71,985 in the first quarter of 1952. Boys' all wool one-pant suits amounted to 7,999 in contrast to 16,230 produced in the same period in 1952.

Production of Men's and Youths' all wool pants and slacks totalled 296,079 in the first quarter of 1953 while 264,196 of these garments were manufactured during the first quarter of 1952. The manufacture of 143,108 dozen Men's and Youths' fine cotton shirts was reported as against 117,502 in the same quarter last year.



The output of Men's and Youths' fine nylon shirts was 11,716 dozen compared to 7,985 dozen produced in the first quarter of the previous year.

There were 519,962 Women's and Misses' wool coats made in the first quarter of 1953 while production in the same period in 1952 was 473,397. Manufacture of rayon and rayon mixtures dresses totalled 1,814,754 while the production in the first quarter of 1952 amounted to 1,894,092.

Output of nylon blouses continued to increase with 61,439 dozen being reported compared to 58,356, 55,649, 38,727 and 34,831 dozen manufactured in the fourth, third, second and first quarters of 1952.
