

Third Quarter, 1953

In the third quarter of 1953 the production of Men's and Youths' all wool one-pant suits showed little change from that of the third quarter of 1952, while a decrease is noted in the production of Women's and Misses' dresses.

Production of Men's and Youths' all wool one-pant suits amounted to 214,609 compared to 212,110 in the corresponding quarter of 1952. All wool twopant suits totalled 74, 273 as against 55, 151 in the third quarter of 1952. Boy's all wool one-pant suits amounted to 4,588 in contrast to 12,550 produced in the same period in 1952.

There were 197,487 Men's and Youths' all wool pants and slacks produced in the third quarter of 1953 while 241,541 of these garments were manufactured during the third quarter of 1952. The manufacture of 130, 162 dozen Men's and Youths' fine cotton shirts was reported as against 117,759 dozen in the same quarter last year.



The output of Men's and Youths' fine nylon shirts was 6,607 dozen compared to 8,495 dozen produced in the second quarter of the previous year.

There were 495,892 Women's and Misses' wool coats made in the third quarter of 1953, while production in the same period in 1952 amounted to 455,027. Manufacture of Women's and Misses' dresses, all materials, totalled 2,703,445 while production in the third quarter of 1952 amounted to 2,801,455.

Production of Women's and Misses' nylon blouses showed an increase, 71,718 dozen being reported compared to 55,649 dozen in the corresponding period last year.
