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
#### QUARTERLY PRODUCTION OF GARMENTS

(Selected Items)

The production of Men's and Youths' all wool one-pant suits in the fourth quarter of 1953 showed a small increase over that of the corresponding quarter of 1952, while a decline is indicated in the production of Women's and Misses! dresses, all materials.

There were 246,861 Men's and Youths' all wool one-pant suits produced compared to 237,410 in the same period last year. All wool two-pant suits totalled 77,232 as against 60,800 in the fourth quarter of 1952. Boy's all wool one-pant suits amounted to 3,728 in contrast to 12,098 produced in the last quarter of 1952.

Production of Men's and Youths' all wool pants and slacks totalled 190,701 in the fourth quarter of 1953, compared to 190,397 manufactured in the fourth quarter of 1952. The manufacture of 181,802 dozen Men's and Youths' fine cotton shirts was reported as against 150,857 dozen in the same period last year.



The output of Men's and Youths' fine nylon shirts was 9,767 dozen compared to 10,079 dozen produced in the corresponding quarter of 1952.

There were 312,956 Women's and Misses' wool coats made in the fourth quarter of 1953 while production in the same period in 1952 amounted to 330,840. Manufacture of Women's and Misses' dresses, all materials totalled 2,650,030 while production in the fourth quart er of 1952 amounted to 2,940,951.

Production of Women's and Misses' nylon blouses showed little change, 59,659 dozen being reported compared to 58,356 dozen in the corresponding period last year.
