
## QUARTERLY PRODUCTION OF GARMENTS

(Selected Items)

Search Of there were more Men's and Youths' all wool one-pant suits produced in the third quarter of 1954 than in the corresponding quarter last year, while the total production of Women's and Misses' dresses declined.

Production of Men's and Youths' all wool one-pant suits amounted to 249,370 compared to 214,609 manufactured in the same period in 1953. All wool two-pant suits totalled 76,652 as against 74,273 in the third quarter of 1953. Production of Boy's all wool one-pant suits was down 2,741 being reported in contrast to 4,588 in the same period in 1953.

Production of Men's and Youths' all wool pants and slacks totalled 169,793, a decrease compared to the third quarter of 1953 when 197,487 were manufactured. There were 129, 156 Men's and Youths' fine cotton shirts produced as against 130, 162 in the third quarter of 1953.



The production of Men's and Youths' fine nylon shirts amounted to 8,650 dozen compared to 6,607 dozen in the corresponding quarter of 1953.

There were 2,448,010 Women's and Misses' dresses produced in the third quarter of 1954, while production in the same period in 1953 amounted to 2,703,445. Women's and Misses! wool coats totalled 457,051 compared to 495,892 in the third quarter of 1953.

The output of Women's and Misses' nylon blouses was lower, 46, 107 dozen being reported as against 71,718 in the corresponding quarter last year.
