
QUARTERLY PRODUCTION OF GARMENTS

(Selected Items)

In the fourth quarter of 1954 the production of Men's and Youths' all wool one-pant suits increased over the production in the corresponding quarter of 1953, while a decrease was indicated in the manufacture of Women's and Misses' dresses, all materials.

Production of Men's and Youths' all wool one-pant suits amounted to 286,134 compared to 246,861 in the same period last year. All wool two-pant suits totalled 100,095 as against 77,232 in the fourth quarter of 1953. Production of Boys' all wool one-pant suits amounted to 1,730 compared to 3,728 in the same quarter last year.

There were 170,247 Men's and Youths' all wool pants and slacks produced in the fourth quarter of 1954, a decrease compared to the fourth quarter of 1953 when 190,701 were made. The manufacture of 144,683 dozen Men's and Youths' fine cotton dress shirts was reported as against 181,802 dozen in the same period last year.



Production of Men's and Youths' fine nylon shirts was 8,026 dozen compared to 9,767 dozen in the corresponding quarter of 1953.

There were 2,489,325 Women's and Misses' dresses manufactured in the fourth quarter of 1954, while production in the same period in 1953 amounted to 2,650,030. Production of Women's and Misses' wool coats totalled 314,969 compared to 312,956 in the fourth quarter of 1953.

The production of Women's and Misses' nylon blouses declined, with 38,085 dozen reported as against 59,659 in the corresponding quarter last year.
