


# QUARTERLY PRODUCTION OF GARMENTS

(Selected Items)

In the third quarter of 1955 the production of Men's and Youths' all wool one pant suits was slightly lower than that of the corresponding quarter of 1954 but an increase in the total production of Women's and Misses' dresses was reported.

There were 242,116 Men's and Youths' all wool one pant suits produced compared to 249,370 in the same period last year. All wool two pant suits totalled 78,869 as against 76,652 in the third quarter of 1954. Boys! suits of all types and materials amounted to 32,298 in contrast to 33,908 manufactured in the corresponding quarter last year.

Production of Men's and Youths' all wool pants and slacks totalled 166,435 compared to 169,793 made in the third quarter of 1954. The manufacture of 8,345 dozen Men's and Youths! nylon dress shirts was reported, as against 8,650 dozen in the same period last year.



The output of Men's and Youths' fine cotton dress shirts was 136.035 dozen, compared to 129, 156 dozen in the corresponding quarter of 1954.

There were 2,648,965 Women's and Misses' dresses made in the third quarter of 1955 while production in the same period last year amounted to 2,448,010. Manufacture of Women's and Misses' all wool coats totalled 451,710 while production in the third quarter of 1954 amounted to 457,051.

The production of Women's and Misses' cotton blouses was higher, 54,349 dozen being made compared to 50,935 dozen in the third quarter of 1954.
