
QUARTERLY PRODUCTION OF GARMENTS

(Selected Items)

There were fewer Men's and Youths' all wool one-pant suits produced in the final quarter of 1955 than in the corresponding period in 1954, while an increase was shown in the production of Women's and Misses! dresses.

Production of Men's and Youths' all wool one-pant suits was 244,254 compared to 286,134 in the fourth quarter of 1954, and 83,793 all wool two-pant suits were produced as against 100,095 in the same period in the preceding year. Total production of Boys' suits was 34,363 in contrast to 29,222 produced in the fourth quarter of 1954.

There were 211,197 all wool pants and slacks manufactured, an increase over 170,247 reported in the same period last year. Production of Men's and Youths' nylon dress shirts amounted to 7,812 dozen, against 8,026 dozen in the fourth quarter of 1954.



A total of 173,077 dozen Men's and Youths' fine cotton dress shirts was reported, compared to 144,683 dozen in the corresponding period in 1954.

Manufacture of Women's and Misses! dresses amounted to 2,713,031, while production in the fourth quarter of 1954 totalled 2,489,325. There were 312,469 Women's and Misses' wool coats made, compared to 314,969 in the same period in the preceding year.

The output of Women's and Misses! cotton blouses increased, 62,456 dozen being produced in contrast to 51,492 dozen in the final quarter of 1954.
