
QUARTERLY PRODUCTION OF GARMENTS

(Selected Items)

The production of Men's and Youths' all wool one pant suits was higher in the first quarter of 1956 than in the corresponding quarter last year, and the total production of Women's and Misses' dresses also increased.

There were 294,809 Men's and Youths' all wool one pant suits manufactured compared to 273,270 in the first quarter of 1955, and 88,673 all wool two pant suits as against 104,702 in the same period last year. Boys' suits, of all types and materials, totalled 67,154 compared to 48,893 in the first quarter of 1955.

Total amount of Men's and Youths' all wool pants and slacks was 277,745 in contrast to 229,796 manufactured in the first quarter last year. There were 12,979 dozen Men's and Youths' nylon dress shirts produced, an increase over 5,826 dozen made in the comparable period last year.



The production of Men's and Youths' fine cotton dress shirts was also higher, 171,356 dozen being reported compared to 152,724 dozen in the first quarter of 1955.

There were 3,193,613 Women's and Misses' dresses produced, as against 2,927,436 in the same period last year. Manufacture of Women's and Misses' all wool and partly wool coats totalled 457,134, against 451,415 in the first quarter of 1955.

Production of Women's and Misses' cotton blouses was down, with a total of 100,389 dozen manufactured, while 108,202 dozen were made in the corresponding quarter of 1955.
