
QUARTERLY PRODUCTION OF GARMENTS

(Selected Items)

The production of Men's and Youths' all wool one pant suits was lower in the third quarter of 1956 than in the corresponding quarter of 1955, and production of Women's and Misses' dresses also declined.

There were 239,677 all wool one pant suits manufactured compared to 242,116 in the third quarter of 1955 and 61,605 all wool two pant suits as against 78,869 in the same period. Boys' suits totalled 27,279 a decrease from the 32,298 produced in the third quarter of 1955.

Total number of Men's and Youths' all wool pants and slacks was 240,611 an increase over 166,435 reported in the same period in 1955. There were 7,632 dozen nylon dress shirts produced, compared to 8,345 dozen in the corresponding quarter of 1955.



Production of Men's and Youths' fine cotton dress shirts was higher with 147,851 dozen reported against 136,035 dozen in 1955.

There were 2,550,864 Women's and Misses' dresses produced compared to 2,648,965 in the same period of 1955. Manufacture of Women's and Misses' all wool coats totalled 429,813 against 451,710 in the comparable 1955 period.

Production of Women's and Misses' cotton blouses was higher with a total of 67,287 dozen, while 54,349 dozen were reported in the third quarter of 1955.
