
QUARTERLY PRODUCTION OF GARMENTS

(Selected Items)

In the fourth quarter of 1956, the production of men's and youths' all wool one pant suits was higher than in the corresponding period in 1955, while a decrease in the production of women's and misses' dresses was reported.

There were 265,514 men's and youths' all wool one pant suits manufactured compared to 244,254 in the same period in 1955, and 76,957 all wool two pant suits compared to 83,793 in the same quarter of the previous year. Total production of boys' suits was higher 45,267 being made, against 34,363 in the corresponding quarter of 1955.

Production of men's and youths' all wool pants and slacks showed an increase with 274,009 reported, compared to 211,197 in the fourth quarter of 1955. A total of 11,311 dozen men's and youths' nylon dress shirts was reported as against 7,812 dozen in the same period in the previous year.



The output of men's and youths' fine cotton dress shirts showed little change, 174,056 dozen being produced compared to 173,077 dozen in the same period in 1955.

There were 2,592,172 women's and misses' dresses manufactured, in contrast to 2,713,031 produced in the fourth quarter of the previous year. Production of women's and misses' all wool coats amounted to 326,417 compared to 312,469 in the comparable period in 1955.

The production of women's and misses' cotton blouses was lower, 58,182 dozen being reported compared to 62,456 in the corresponding quarter of 1955.
