THE FUR GOODS INDUSTRY, CANADA, 1931

INTRODUCTION

Production.— Although prices of most kinds of goods manufactured of fur were lower in 1931 than in any one of the preceding four or five years, and although the world-wide depression affected adversely the sale of all articles which might be classed as luxuries, the fur goods industry came through the year fairly well, showing a decrease in total value from the preceding year of only 9 per cent, compared with a decrease of 17 per cent between 1929 and 1930. The total value of output of the establishments in 1931 was \$14,246,993, compared with \$15,733,768 in 1930 and \$18,944,726 in 1929. Women's coats, fur and fur lined, had a total value in 1931 of \$8,219,989, or about half of the total value of all fur goods manufactured during the year. The number of these coats was about 3,000 less than in the preceding year and the total value was \$1,727,744 less. Fur collars, cuffs and stoles show a value of \$2,411,223, compared with \$2,568,498 in 1930. Muffs, of which there were only 420 manufactured in 1930, show a production in 1931 of 2,510. Other items of production include men's coats, gloves and gauntlets, robes, fur trimming, etc. The following table gives quantity and value of the different items for the years 1929, 1930 and 1931.

Establishments.- The number of establishments engaged in the manufacture of fur goods during the year 1931 was 268, located by provinces as follows: Ontario, 135; Quebec, 99; Manitoba, 18; Alberta, 9; British Columbia, 3; New Brunswick, 2; and Nova Scotia and Saskatchewan each 1. Compared with the preceding year, there is a total increase of 52, the increase being distributed among the provinces as follows: Ontario, 18; Quebec, 29; Manitoba, 2; and Alberta, New Brunswick and Nova Scotia, 1 each.

THE FUR GOODS INDUSTRY, CANADA

Capital.- The capital investment of the industry rose from \$11,592,105 in 1930 to \$12,131,475 in 1931, the increase being due almost entirely to the value shown by the item of "land, buildings and machinery". The amounts recorded as the total value of capital in 1930 and 1931 were apportioned as follows, the figures for 1930 being placed within brackets: land, buildings and machinery, \$3,413,393 (\$2,138,136); materials, products and supplies on hand, \$5,164,293 (\$5,154,754); and cash and accounts and bills receivable, \$3,553,789 (\$4,299,215).

Employees and Salaries and Wages.- The number of persons employed by the industry during the year was 2,879, an increase of 82 compared with the preceding year. The total for 1931 comprises 572 persons employed on a salary basis, and an average for the year of 2,307 wage-earners. Statistics of the number of wage-earners by months show employment at its peak in the months September to December, in preparation for the winter season, with a sharp drop in January and February. The amount paid in salaries during the year was \$1,059,214, and in wages, \$2,434,983, a total of \$3,494,197, compared with a total of \$3,596,751 in 1930.

Materials Used.- Furs purchased already dressed for use in the manufacture of fur goods in 1931 had a total value of \$5,385,856, furs purchased undressed a value of \$2,171,568, and other materials, comprising linings, trimmings, etc., a value of \$1,047,735. The total value of furs and other materials used during the year was \$8,605,159, compared with \$9,537,657 in 1930.

FOREIGN TRADE

Exports.- The value of raw furs of Canadian origin exported during the calendar year 1931 was \$13,406,552, of which 6,578,152 dollars' worth went to the United Kingdom and 5,343,338 dollars' worth to the United States. The principal item is silver or black fox, of which there were 115,800 skins exported, with a total value of \$4,899,892. Next in order of value is the item "fox skins, other than black or silver", with a value of \$1,812,511, and this is followed by muskrat with a value of \$1,474,017, beaver with a value of \$1,355,163, and mink with a value of \$1,252,723. Other furs of importance in the export trade are fisher, lynx, marten and wolf. The exports of dressed furs and of fur goods are of small importance, the value of the former in 1931 amounting to only \$60,385 and of the latter to \$58,126.

Imports.- Raw furs imported into Canada for consumption during the year 1931 had a total value of \$4,188,850, the kinds specified in the trade tables including fox, kolinsky, mink, muskrat, Persian lamb and rabbit. Dressed furs and manufactures of fur imported in the same year had a total value of \$2,055,677. The great bulk of the furs imported came from the United States, the value of the imports of raw and dressed furs and fur goods from that country in 1931 amounting to \$4,945,371, or 79 per cent of the total imports of fur.

GENERAL TABLES

The general tables give detailed statistics of the fur goods industry for the year 1931, by provinces, and following these tables is a report of the fur dressing industry. The last part of the volume contains statistics of imports and exports of furs, by items and by countries, and a list of the fur goods and fur dressing establishments.

THE FUR DRESSING INDUSTRY, CANADA

Establishments.- The number of establishments engaged in the dressing and dyeing of furs for the trade in 1931, was 11, distributed by provinces as follows: Quebec, 6; Ontario, 4; and Manitoba, 1. Compared with the preceding year the number of establishments in Quebec shows an increase of 1, while in the other provinces no change is recorded.

Fur Skins Treated.- The total number of skins of all kinds treated during the year 1931 was 7,034,498, a decrease from the preceding year of 107,537 and a decrease from 1929 of 599,411. The decrease in total is due to the smaller number of mole skins treated - 1,922,579 in 1929, 1,427,249 in 1930 and only 568,588 in 1931. The number of muskrat skins shows an increase over 1930 of 574,489, and the number of silver fox skins an increase of 11,988. Other kinds of furs of which large numbers were treated in 1931 are the following: rabbit, squirrel, opossum, skunk, Persian lamb and goat.

The total amount received by the establishments for the work of treating the furs in 1931 was \$1,571,740, compared with \$1,625,824 in 1930 and \$1,916,313 in 1929.




