THE FUR GOODS INDUSTRY, CANADA, 1933.

Production.— The total value of all products of the fur goods industry in 1933 was \$11,551,695, compared with \$10,791,838 in 1932 and \$14,246,993 in 1931. As may be seen by the accompanying chart, this is the first year since 1928 that there has been an up-turn in value, the increased demand for furs being the result of the unusually cold weather prevailing during the winter of 1933-34, as well as of the lower prices which brought fur goods within reach of a larger number of people. The number of fur coats made for men increased from 1,132 in 1932 to 2,359 in 1933, and the number made in sizes for women from 55,306 to 65,421. The average price for men's fur coats in 1933 was \$51, compared with \$69 in 1932 and \$67 in 1931, and the average for women's fur coats, \$98, in comparison with \$104 in 1932 and \$124 in 1931. Fur muffs have again become fashionable, the number increasing from 2,510 in 1931 to 6,036 in 1932 and to 14,876 in 1933. Other items of importance are cuffs, collars and scarves of fur, and fur trimming. The amount received for custom work, repairs and storage of furs was \$2,209,270, compared with \$2,295,596 in 1932 and \$2,445,740 in 1931.

## THE FUR GOODS INDUSTRY, CANADA

Number of Establishments and Value of Capital.— The number of establishments making fur goods as their principal product in 1933 was 322, distributed by provinces as follows: Ontario, 155; Quebec, 125; Manitoba, 27; Alberta, 7; British Columbia, 4; Saskatchewan, 2; and Nova Scotia and New Brunswick, 1 each. The total number shows an increase over 1932 of 53, many of the establishments added to the list being of small size with output consisting chiefly of repair work. The value of the capital investment amounted to \$9,392,890, apportioned as follows: land, buildings and machinery, \$2,941,094; materials and products on hand, stocks in process, etc., \$3,491,184; and cash and accounts and bills receivable, \$2,960,612. Compared with the preceding year, the total capital investment shows a decrease of \$397,377. The average capital per establishment in 1933 was \$29,170, compared with \$36,395 in 1932.

Employees and Salaries and Wages.— Both the number of employees and the salary and wage bill show increases over 1932, the former an increase of 8 per cent and the latter an increase of 1 per cent. The industry in 1933 gave employment to 639 salaried employees with salaries of \$961,503, and 2,090 wage-earners with wages of \$1,840,945. Each group shows an increase over 1932 in number and in amounts paid. The last five months of the year provided the period of greatest employment for wage-earners, the peak being reached in November, when 2,810 persons were on the pay-roll. February was the month of lowest employment with a total of 1,324.

Materials Used.— The value of the furs and skins used in the manufacture of the various kinds of fur goods was \$6,032,992, and the value of other materials (linings, buttons, thread, etc.) \$829,845, making a total of \$6,862,837, an increase over 1932 of \$474,463, or 7 per cent.

## FOREIGN TRADE

Exports.— Canada exports annually large quantities of raw furs, but her export trade in dressed furs and manufactures of furs is of comparatively little importance. The total value of Canadian furs exported during the calendar year 1933 was \$12,140,915, divided as follows: fur skins, undressed, \$11,924,885; fur skins, dressed, \$171,809; and manufactures of furs, \$44,221. Compared with the preceding year the total value shows an increase of \$1,185,472, or 11 per cent. The United Kingdom and the United States provide the chief markets for Canadian furs, the former in 1933 taking 62 per cent of the total exports, measured according to value, and the latter, 27 per cent.

Imports.— The value of raw and dressed furs and manufactures of furs imported into Canada in 1933 was \$3,911,838, of which 70 per cent came from the United States and 11 per cent from the United Kingdom. The total value shows an increase over 1932 of \$82,279.

### THE FUR DRESSING INDUSTRY, CANADA

The fur dressing and dyeing industry of Canada in 1933 numbered 13 plants, distributed by provinces as follows: Quebec 6; Ontario 4; Manitoba 2; and British Columbia 1. The total number of skins treated was slightly less than the number recorded for 1932, but the amount received for the work was greater by 5 per cent. The principal kinds of skins, according to number treated, were muskrat, rabbit and squirrel.

The total amount received by the plants for the dressing and dyeing of the furs was \$1,449,232, compared with \$1,384,511 in 1932 and \$1,571,740 in 1931.

The following tables show (1) principal statistics of the fur dressing and dyeing industry in 1933, by provinces, and (2) the number of skins treated, by kinds, in the years 1931 to 1933.
