THE FUR GOODS INDUSTRY, CANADA, 1934.

The manufacture in Canada of goods of various kinds from the dressed and dyed or undyed skins of fur-bearing animals constitutes an industry which supplies practically the entire quantity of fur goods consumed annually in the Dominion. The industry provided employment in 1934 for 2,888 persons, paid in salaries and wages an amount of \$2,963,630, and produced goods to the value of \$12,656,722. The number of plants engaged in manufacture was 320, distributed by provinces as follows: Nova Scotia, 2; New Brunswick, 1; Quebec, 126; Ontario, 151; Manitoba, 27; Saskatchewan, 3; Alberta, 5; and British Columbia, 5. Quebec and Ontario are the principal fur goods manufacturing provinces, the value of production of the former in 1934 representing 46 per cent and of the latter 43 per cent of the total value of output for the whole of Canada. The goods made consist chiefly of articles of wearing apparel for women. The number of women's coats, fur and fur-lined, manufactured in 1934 totalled 76,910, valued at \$7,078,987, while coats for men, fur and fur-lined, numbered only 4,555, valued at \$217,065. Muffs, which in 1931 again became fashionable after a period of discard, reached a total in 1934 of 80,619, valued at \$234,195. Other articles of manufacture include fur cuffs, collars, scarves, caps and robes. A considerable revenue is derived by the establishments from custom work, repairs and storage, the combined amounts for these in 1934 totalling \$2,373,103. Compared with the preceding year the total value of production of the industry shows an increase of \$1,105,027, or 10 per cent, and an increase over 1932 of \$1,864,884, or 17 per cent.

THE FUR GOODS INDUSTRY, CANADA

Capital - The value of the capital investment of the industry rose from \$9,392,890 in 1933 to \$11,088,213 in 1934. The 1934 total is apportioned by items as follows: land and buildings, \$3,545,029; fixtures, machinery, tools and other equipment, \$650,071; materials on hand, stocks in process, fuel and miscellaneous supplies on hand, \$2,186,616; finished products on hand, \$1,617,519, and cash and accounts and bills receivable, \$3,088,978. The average capital investment per establishment was \$34,650, compared with \$29,170 in 1933.

Employees and Salaries and Wages - The classification "salaried employees" includes managers, superintendents, professional and clerical employees, and these numbered 635 in the year 1934. The wage-earners, or factory workers, numbered 2,253. The total number of all employees - 2,888 - shows an increase over the preceding year of 159. The salaries paid during the year amounted to \$962,760, and the wages to \$2,000,870, a total of \$2,963,630, compared with a total of \$2,802,448 in 1933. Employment in this industry is at its highest in the latter half of the year, in preparation for the winter trade, reaching the peak in November. After December there is a rapid decline, the low months of the year being January, February, March and April. In February, 1934, the number of wage-earners employed was only 1,469, while in November of the same year the number was 2,985.

Materials Used - The returns of this industry do not itemize the various kinds of materials used, but show only the total value of the furs and skins used and the value of all other materials. In 1934 the value of the former was \$6,925,139, and of the latter, \$1,024,333, a total of \$7,949,472, compared with a total of \$6,862,837 in 1933.

FOREIGN TRADE

Exports - Canada's exports of manufactures of furs are of comparatively little importance. In 1934 the value of such exports was \$62,328, compared with \$44,221 in 1933. Canada, however, has an immense export trade in raw furs, the total for the calendar year 1934 amounting to \$14,797,785. Statistics of exports and imports of raw and dressed furs and manufactures of furs are included in the present report.

Imports - Canada's import trade in manufactures of fur is likewise of small importance, amounting in 1934 to only \$64,602. The value of the raw furs imported during the same year was \$3,362,827.

GENERAL TABLES

The general tables give detailed statistics of the fur goods industry for the year 1934, by provinces, and following these tables is a report of the fur dressing industry. The last part of the volume contains statistics of exports and imports, by items and by countries, and lists of the fur goods and fur dressing establishments.

THE FUR DRESSING INDUSTRY, CANADA

The establishments of the fur dressing and dyeing industry of Canada are employed primarily in custom work, that is, the furs are treated for others and a charge made according to the amount of work involved. In 1934 there were 14 establishments engaged in the treatment of furs, located by provinces as follows: Quebec, 6; Ontario, 5; Manitoba, 2; and British Columbia, 1. The number of skins treated was 6,097,995, and the amount received for the work, \$1,499,789, or an average of 25 cents per skin. Muskrat, rabbit and squirrel are the principal kinds of skins treated.

The following tables show (1) the principal statistics of the industry in the years 1932 to 1934, and (2) the number of skins treated, by kinds, in the same years.
