THE FUR GOODS INDUSTRY, CANADA, 1936.

The fur goods industry takes the dressed and dyed or undyed skins of fur-bearing animals and fashions them into wearing apparel of various kinds, such as coats, capes, scarves, collars, cuffs, muffs, etc. Practically the whole demand of the Canadian public for fur goods is met by the home industry, and likewise nearly all of the goods manufactured in Canada are for home consumption --- the import and export trades in manufactured fur goods are of relatively small importance.

The value of output of the industry in 1936 was \$14,474,935, an amount greater than that of the preceding year by nearly two million dollars. The high record for value in the past 15 years is credited to the year 1928, when the amount was \$20,756,071. But prices of fur skins were also high, which fact, rather than a larger quantity of output, accounts for the increased value of fur goods in that year. In the following year prices of fur skins dropped and as a consequence prices of manufactured fur goods were lower, and each year thereafter until 1933 saw a decrease from the preceding year in total value of output. The low year of the period was 1932. The value of the 1936 output exceeds that of 1932 by \$3,683,097, or 34 per cent.

The principal item of production is the fur coat. Those made for women in 1936 totalled 90,602, which is the largest number ever recorded by the Canadian fur goods industry. The average price for women's fur coats in 1936 was \$93. In the earlier years average prices were much higher, but the quantity of output was considerably less. For example, in 1923, the number of women's fur coats made was only 33,569, but the average price of \$189 gave a total value for the output of \$6,358,143. The number produced in 1936, therefore, was 170 per cent greater than the product of 1923, but the total value was only 32 per cent more. The output of fur coats for men is comparatively small -- only 5,890 were manufactured in 1936. This number, however, is larger than for some years past. In 1932 the production amounted to only 1,132. The muff, in 1934, attained its greatest popularity of the past 20 years, with a total of 80,619, but the number decreased to 35,895 in the following year and rose slightly to 39,503 in 1936. A large part of the industry's revenue is derived from custom work, repairs and storage of furs. The total for this item in 1936 was \$2,240,341, or 15 per cent of the total value of production.

The following table gives production by items, for the years 1934 to 1936, while Table II presents the principal statistics of the industry in the years 1921 to 1936.

Establishments. - There were 331 establishments recorded in the fur goods industry in 1936, compared with 309 in the preceding year. Following is the distribution of the establishments by provinces, the figures for 1935 being placed within brackets: Ontario, 155 (148); Quebec, 123 (113); Manitoba, 34 (31); British Columbia, 7 (5); Alberta, 6 (6); Saskatchewan, 4 (4); Nova Scotia, 1 (1); and New Brunswick, 1 (1).

## THE FUR GOODS INDUSTRY, CANADA.

Capital. - The capital investment had a total value of \$11,510,199 divided as follows: land, buildings and machinery \$4,174,229; materials and products on hand stocks in process, etc., \$3,654,734; and cash and accounts and bills receivable, \$3,681,236. Compared with the preceding year the total amount shows an increase of \$1,035,263, or 10 per cent.

Employees and Salaries and Wages. - The total number of employees recorded for the year was 3,153, of which 750 are classified as salaried employees and 2,403 as wage-earners. To the salaried employees the amount paid for services during the year was \$1,116,942, and to the factory workers, \$2,254,424, a total for all employes of \$3,371,366. The low month for employment was February with a total of 1,649 wage earners on the pay-roll. Thereafter employment rose steadily each month, until the peak was reached in November with a total of 2,981. The records of weekly hours of employment in the industry show that the group of those working 40 hours or less per week contains 1,733 persons, or 52 per cent of the total number of wage-earners. The second largest group is of those working 44 hours (850 persons, or 25 per cent of the total); the third group, those working 48 hours (310 persons, or 9 per cent of the whole number); and the fourth group, those working from 49-50 hours (250 persons, or 7 per cent of the total). No employee worked more than 54 hours per week, and the number in this group was only 90, or 3 per cent of the total number of wage-earners employed.

Materials Used. - The value of the dressed furs and skins used in the manufacture of the various kinds of fur goods was \$8,224,681, and the value of other materials, such as linings, buttons, thread, etc., \$911,361 -- a total of \$9,136,042 for all materials used. This compares with a total of \$7,844,084 in the preceding year. Information is not available concerning the kinds of fur skins used.

### FOREIGN TRADE

Exports. - There is a very large export trade in raw furs, but the exports of dressed furs and of manufactures of furs are relatively of little importance. The total value of raw furs exported in the calendar year 1936 was \$16,889,328, while the dressed skins exported had a value of \$637,118, and the manufactures of furs a value of only \$139,767. Among the various kinds of raw furs exported, the first in importance is silver fox, with a value of \$6,110,038, and second is mink with a value of \$2,673,973. The total value of the exports of all furs -- raw, dressed and manufactured -- was \$17,666,213, of which exports to the United Kingdom amounted to \$9,603,161, or 54 per cent of the whole, to the United States, \$7,265,603, or 41 per cent, and to all other countries combined, \$797,449, or 5 per cent.

Imports. - The furs imported into Canada in 1936 had a total value of \$7,000,917, divided as follows: fur skins, undressed, \$4,591,478; fur skins, wholly or partially dressed, \$1,337,033; hatters' furs, not on the skin, \$972,309; and manufactures of furs, \$100,097. Among the several kinds of raw furs imported, the principal single item is Persian lamb. The division of imports according to country of origin, shows the United States leading with a value of \$4,272,302, or 61 per cent of the total imports. Following are the United Kingdom, \$1,094,031, or 16 per cent; Belgium, \$680,619, or 10 per cent; France, \$551,066, or 8 per cent; and other countries, combined, \$402,899, or 5 per cent.

THE FUR DRESSING INDUSTRY, CANADA

The number of fur dressing establishments in operation in Canada in 1936 was 14, an increase of one over the preceding year. The number is distributed by provinces as follows: Quebec, 7; Ontario, 5; and Manitoba, 2. The industry is engaged entirely in custom work, i.e., the furs belonging to customers are treated by the establishments and charges made according to the kind and amount of work involved. In 1936 the amount received by the industry for custom work was \$1,516,762, an increase over the preceding year of \$142,015, or 10 per cent, and over the year 1934 of \$16,973, or 1 per cent. The number of fur skins treated during the year 1936 was 6,221,363, compared with 5,738,920 in 1935 and 6,097,995 in 1934. The principal kind, with regard to number treated, is rabbit, which records a total of 3,256,879 skins. The next largest number is shown by muskrat with 955,181, and the third by squirrel with 430,552. This order is noted in each of the four years preceding 1936, as well.

In Table 1 will be found the principal statistics of the fur dressing industry in the years 1934 to 1936, and in Table 2, the number of skins treated, by kinds, in the same years.
