THE FUR GOODS INDUSTRY, CANADA, 1937.

The fur goods industry takes the dressed and dyed or undyed skins of fur-bearing animals and fashions them into various items of wearing apparel, such as coats, capes, scarves, collars, cuffs, muffs, etc. Practically the whole demand of the Canadian public for fur goods is met by the home industry, and likewise the Canadian consumption absorbs the bulk of the product - the import and export trades in manufactured fur goods are of relatively small importance.

The industry reached its high record for value of production in the year 1928, when the total value was \$20,756,071. After that year there was an annual decline in value until the low point was reached with \$10,791,838 in 1932. The years following 1932, with one exception, record increases, and in 1937 the value was \$16,261,100, an increase over the preceding year of \$1,786,165, or 12 per cent, and an increase over 1932, the low year of the period, of \$5,469,262, or 51 per cent. The average value of production of the seventeen-year period, 1921 to 1937, was \$14,785,812.

The output of the industry consists chiefly of fur goods for women's wear. In 1937 the value of the products listed as for the wear of women exclusively, i.e. women's fur and fur-lined coats and jackets, capes, scarves, muffs and fur trimming, amounted to \$11,229,705, or 69 per cent of the total value of all products of the industry. There are, in addition, general items, such as collars, cuffs and gauntlets, for which the quantities made for women's wear are not recorded separately.

The production of women's fur coats has shown a steady annual increase, mounting from 31,604 in 1921 to 100,133 in 1937, while the total value has risen from \$6,704,138 to \$9,517,721. The increased consumption of this article is due, no doubt, to the general reduction in price, which brings it within the means of a greater number of people. The average price per coat in 1937 was \$95, compared with an average of \$212 in 1921.

The following table gives production in the years 1935 to 1937, by kind, quantity and value: table II presents the principal statistics of the industry in the years 1921 to 1937.

Establishments.— There were 351 establishments recorded in the fur goods industry in 1937, compared with 331 in the preceding year. Following is the distribution of the establishments by provinces, the figures for 1936 being placed within brackets: Ontario, 160 (155); Quebec, 135 (123); Manitoba, 35 (34); Alberta, 9 (6); British Columbia, 7 (7); Saskatchewan, 3 (4); Nova Scotia, 1 (1); and New Brunswick, 1 (1).

Capital.-- The capital investment of the industry had a total value in 1937 of \$12,034,990, apportioned by items as follows: land, buildings and machinery, \$4,341,936; materials and products on hand, stocks in process, etc., \$3,978,088; an cash and accounts and bills receivable, \$3,714,966. Compared with the preceding year, the total amount shows an increase of \$524,791, or 5 per cent.

Employees and Salaries and Wages.-- The number of persons employed during the year was 3,419. This number is the largest in the history of the industry and exceeds the previous high record (that of the year 1936) by 266, or 8 per cent. The salaries and wages paid amounted to \$3,730,176, an increase over 1936 of \$358,810, or 11 per cent. Statistics of the number of wage-earners by months show that employment is at its lowest in February, and that increased activity is shown each month thereafter until the peak is reached in November. In 1937 the number of wage-earners recorded for the month of February was 1,769, and for November, 3,137, an increase in the period of 1,368, or 77 per cent. An arrangement of the numbers of wage-earners, by groups, according to regular weekly hours of employment, places 63 per cent of the total number in the group of those working 40 hours or less per week. The second largest group is the one containing employees working 44 hours, and this represents 14 per cent of the total number. The number of employees in the combined groups with classifications of more than 54 hours represents only 1 per cent of the total.

Materials Used.-- The value of the materials used in the manufacture of fur goods was \$10,485,009, comprising \$9,560,953, the value of dressed furs and skins, and \$924,056, the value of all other materials, such as linings, trimmings, thread, etc. Information concerning the kinds of furs used is not available.

FOREIGN TRADE

Exports.-- Canada's exportation of furs consists chiefly of the undressed article. In 1937 the value of all furs exported was \$17,515,460, of which the amount of \$16,494,997, or 94 per cent of the whole, is credited to the export of raw furs. The value of the dressed furs exported was \$837,328, or 5 per cent of the total for all furs, and of manufactures of furs, \$183,135, or 1 per cent. The United Kingdom and the United States provide the chief markets for Canadian furs. Exports to the United Kingdom in 1937 had a value of \$10,722,537 and to the United States, \$5,728,014, these amounts representing 61 per cent and 33 per cent respectively of the total exports. The principal single items of export in 1937 were: fox skins, black and silver, (\$6,785,440); mink skins (\$1,730,280); fox skins, other than black or silver (\$1,583,251); beaver skins (\$1,140,738); and muskrat skins (\$1,130,353).

Imports.-- The imports into Canada, for consumption, of furs in the calendar year 1937 had a value of \$8,169,840, divided as follows: fur skins, undressed, \$5,348,694; fur skins, wholly or partially dressed, \$2,558,080, and manufactures of furs, \$263,066. The principal single items of import are the following: rabbit skins (\$931,041) and Persian lamb skins (\$839,326).

GENERAL TABLES

THE FUR DRESSING INDUSTRY, CANADA.

The fur dressing industry of Canada is chiefly on a custom basis, that is, the work of dressing and dyeing the furs is completed for customers, at a certain charge per pelt. The amount received in 1937 for the treatment of the furs was \$1,397,767, a decrease from the preceding year of \$118,995, or 8 per cent, but an increase over the year 1935 of \$23,020, or 2 per cent. The number of establishments in operation in 1936 and in 1937 was 14, distributed by provinces as follows: Quebec, 7; Ontario, 5; and Manitoba, 2. The number of skins treated in the year 1937 was 4,004,620, compared with 6,221,363 in 1936. Contributing chiefly to the decrease in total is the item of rabbit skins, which dropped from 3,256,879 in 1936 to 1,522,623 in 1937. Rabbit, however, is still the principal item, and is followed by muskrat with 987,713. The number of silver fox skins treated was 39,883, an increase of 14,157 over the preceding year and an increase of 29,347 over the year 1935.

In table 1 will be found the principal statistics of the fur dressing industry in the years 1935 to 1937, and in table 2, the number of skins treated, by kinds, in the same years.
