THE FUR GOODS INDUSTRY, CANADA, 1938.

The fur goods industry takes the dressed and dyed or undyed skins of fur-bearing animals and manufactures them into various items of apparel, such as coats, capes, scarves, collars, cuffs, muffs, etc. Practically the whole demand of the Canadian public for fur goods is met by the home industry, and likewise the Canadian consumption absorbs the bulk of the product - the import and export of manufactured fur goods are of relatively small importance. **Formerly** the pelts of Canadian origin which were used in manufacture were of animals taken in the wild, but of late years the fur farming industry, which is now firmly established in all provinces, is able to supply a good proportion of the number of domestic pelts required. 1/

The value of production of the fur goods industry in 1938 was \$16,012,245, a decrease from the preceding year of \$248,855, or 2 per cent, but an **increase** over the year 1936 of \$1,537,310, or 11 per cent. The greater part of the output consists of goods for women's wear - coats, capes, scarves, etc. The number of women's fur coats made was 105,846, with a total value of \$9,752,304, compared with 100,133 and a total value of \$9,517,721 in 1937. Fur coats for men totalled only 3,551, with a value of \$190,817, compared with 4,244 and a value of \$222,414 in the preceding year.

The industry is centred chiefly in the provinces of Quebec and Ontario. In 1938 the value of output of the Quebec establishments was \$7,378,162 and of the Ontario plants, \$6,700,685, these amounts representing **respectively 46 and 42 per cent** of the total for Canada. The number of establishments in operation during the year was 366, distributed by provinces as follows: Quebec, 135; Ontario, 169; Manitoba, 39; Alberta, 10; British Columbia, 7; Saskatchewan, 4; and Nova Scotia and New Brunswick, 1 each.

Table I, which follows, presents the various items of production, by quantity and value, in the years 1936 to 1938, while in table II will be found the principal statistics of the industry from 1921 to 1938.

1/ The raw fur production statistics for the 12 months ended June 30, 1938, estimated that the value of pelts sold from fur farms would represent 43 per cent of the total value of all pelts produced in the period mentioned.

FOREIGN TRADE

Exports.- Canada has an annual export trade in raw furs amounting to many millions of dollars, but of the fur skins treated in this country and the fur goods manufactured, only small quantities are for export. The value of Canadian furs exported in 1938 was \$14,096,503, of which undressed fur skins account for \$13,590,224, or 96 per cent; fur skins, dressed, for \$354,173, or 3 per cent; and manufactured fur goods, for \$152,106, or 1 per cent. The greater part of the exports of dressed fur skins went to the United Kingdom, while the United States took the bulk of the exports of fur goods. For all furs, comprising raw and dressed skins and manufactured goods, the value of exports to the United Kingdom represented 62 per cent of the whole, and to the United States, 32 per cent. Compared with the preceding year, the total value of exports of furs shows a decrease of \$3,418,957, or 20 per cent.

Imports.- The imports of furs in the year 1938 were valued at \$5,650,624 compared with \$8,169,840 in 1937. The total for 1938 comprises \$3,743,548 as the value of the undressed fur skins; \$1,704,932, the value of skins wholly or partially dressed; and \$202,144, the value of manufactures of furs.

GENERAL TABLES

The general tables of the present report give detailed statistics of the fur goods industry for the year 1938, by provinces, and following these tables is a report of the fur dressing industry. The volume contains, also, statistics of imports and exports, by items and by countries, and lists of the fur goods and fur dressing industries.

THE FUR DRESSING INDUSTRY, CANADA, 1938.

There are in Canada 14 plants engaged in the dressing and dyeing of fur skins. The work is established on a custom basis, that is, the customer sends the pelts to be treated and is charged an amount per skin, which varies with the work performed. In the year 1938 the number of skins treated was 4,197,079, an increase over the preceding year of 192,459. In order of number treated, the principal kinds were muskrat (1,374,930) and rabbit (1,318,904). Other kinds for which large numbers are recorded are the following: squirrel (389,249), opossum (205,937), persian lamb (178,274) and skunk (161,661). Silver fox, which is the product of the fur farms, shows a total of 70,007, in comparison with 39,883 in the preceding year.

The amount received by the industry for the treatment of the furs was \$1,318,819, compared with \$1,397,767 in 1937. The establishments are located, by provinces, as follows: Quebec, 7; Ontario, 4; and Manitoba, 3.

The principal statistics of the fur dressing industry in the years 1936 to 1938 are presented in the following table, while in table 2 are given, for the same years, the numbers of the various kinds of furs treated.


