THE FUR GOODS INDUSTRY, CANADA, 1939

The value of production of the Canadian fur goods industry in 1939 was \$18,279,866, an increase over the preceding year of \$2,267,621, or 14 per cent. The bulk of the output consists of goods made for women - coats, capes, muffs, etc. The number of women's fur coats manufactured in 1939 was 123,273, valued at \$11,539,195. This is the largest number ever recorded by the industry, although the total value is not the highest. In 1918, the first year for which quantities were recorded, the average price for women's fur coats produced by the industry was \$166, while in 1939 the average was \$94. The high record for average is held by the year 1919 with \$235. The prices of most kinds of raw furs are lower at the present time than in earlier years, which influences the average for the finished article. Next in importance to women's fur coats, in order of value of production in 1939, are: fur trimming (\$852,811); fur collars (\$754,247); fur scarves, etc. (\$720,262); and men's fur coats (\$201,166). A large source of revenue to the industry consists of custom work, repairs and the storage of furs: in 1939 the amount received under this heading was \$2,709,240.

Formerly the pelts of Canadian origin which were used in manufacture by the industry were of animals taken by trappers, but of late years the fur farming industry, which is now firmly established in all provinces, is able to supply a good proportion of the number of domestic pelts required. (a)

The industry is established chiefly in Quebec and Ontario, the value of production of the former province in 1939 representing 47 per cent of the total for Canada, and of the latter province, 41 per cent. Manitoba is third in importance with a product valued at \$1,701,984, or 9 per cent of the total Canadian output, while the product of Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Saskatchewan, Alberta and British Columbia, combined, was \$469,981, or 3 per cent of the total. The number of plants in operation was 370, located by provinces as follows: Quebec, 143; Ontario, 166; Manitoba, 40; and the other provinces, 21.

Table I, which follows, presents the various items of production, by quantity and value, in the years 1937 to 1939, while in table II will be found the principal statistics of the Industry from 1921 to 1939.

(a) The raw fur production statistics for the 12 months ended June 30, 1939, estimated that the value of pelts sold from fur farms would represent 40 per cent of the total value of all pelts produced in the period mentioned.

THE FUR GOODS INDUSTRY

FOREIGN TRADE

Exports.- Canada has an annual export trade in raw furs amounting to many millions of dollars, but of the fur skins treated in this country and of the fur goods manufactured here, only small quantities are for export. The total value of all furs exported in 1939 was \$14,568,986, of which \$14,130,188, or 97 per cent is credited to the raw furs; \$241,482, or 2 per cent, to dressed furs; and \$197,316, or 1 per cent, to manufactured fur goods. Exports to the United Kingdom accounted for \$7,054,745, or 48 per cent, of the whole; to the United States, \$6,772,641, or 47 per cent; and to all other countries, combined, \$741,600, or 5 per cent. Compared with the preceding year, the total export value shows an increase of \$472,483, or 3 per cent.

Imports.- Canada's import trade in furs is of considerable size, also, and, as in the case of the exports, the trade is confined mainly to raw furs. In 1939 the imports of furs had a total value of \$7,133,052, divided as follows: raw furs, \$5,053,506; skins, wholly or partially dressed, \$1,363,882; and manufactured fur goods, \$215,664. The furs imported come chiefly from the United States (\$4,455,938) and the United Kingdom (\$1,018,417). Other countries of importance in the import trade are Belgium, France, Russia and Turkey. Compared with the preceding year the total value of imports shows an increase of \$1,482,428, or 26 per cent.

GENERAL TABLES

The general tables of the present report give detailed statistics of the fur goods industry for the year 1939, by provinces, and following these tables is a report of the fur dressing industry. The volume contains, also, statistics of imports and exports, by items and by countries, and lists of the fur goods and fur dressing establishments.

THE FUR DRESSING INDUSTRY, CANADA, 1939.

There are in Canada 14 plants engaged in the dressing and dyeing of fur skins. The work is established on a custom basis, that is, the customer sends the pelts to be treated and is charged an amount per skin, which varies with the work performed. The number of skins treated by the industry in 1939 was 6,237,505, while the amount received for the work was \$1,681,660, compared with 4,197,079 skins and an amount received of \$1,318,819 in the preceding year. The principal kinds with regard to number of skins treated are muskrat and rabbit, both of which show increases over the preceding year. The number of silver fox skins (practically all from fur farms) treated increased from 70,007 in 1938 to 88,115 in 1939, and the number of mink pelts (many of which are from fur farms) from 19,030 to 34,794.

The plants of the industry are located by provinces as follows: Quebec, 7; Ontario, 4; and Manitoba, 3. Quebec's share of the amount received for the work performed is the largest - \$1,250,834, or 74.4 per cent of the total. The amount received by Ontario was \$308,973, or 18.4 per cent of the whole, and by Manitoba \$121,853, or 7.2 per cent.

The principal statistics of the fur dressing industry in the years 1937 to 1939 are presented in the following table, while in table 2 are given, for the same years, the numbers of the various kinds of furs treated.
