

THE FUR GOODS INDUSTRY, CANADA, 1940

The fur goods industry of Canada in the year 1940 shows a production value of \$22,991,393, which marks a high record for the manufacture to date. Compared with the preceding year there is an increase in value of \$4,711,527, or 26 per cent, and with the year 1938, an advance of \$6,979,148, or 44 per cent. Women's fur coats and jackets constitute the principal item with a total of 148,280, valued at \$15,206,362 - an increase in number over the preceding year of 25,007, and an increase in value of \$3,667,167. Fur coats for men totalled only 1,697 valued at \$160,765, a decrease in number from the preceding year of 1,187, and in value of \$40,401. The industry received for custom work, repairs and storage of furs the amount of \$2,799,967, compared with \$2,709,240 in 1939. The bulk of the fur goods produced in Canada is for domestic consumption, and likewise, practically the entire Canadian demand for fur goods is met by the home product: the imports and exports of fur goods are of small importance.

Formerly the pelts of Canadian origin which were used in manufacture by the industry were of animals taken by trappers, but of late years the fur farming industry, which is now firmly established in all provinces of the Dominion, is able to supply a good proportion of the number of domestic pelts required. (a)

There were 380 fur goods establishments in operation in 1940, located by provinces, as follows: Quebec, 156; Ontario, 162; Manitoba, 40; and the other provinces, combined, 22. Quebec's production value represents 47.8 per cent of the total for Canada, Ontario's, 41.0 per cent, Manitoba's, 8.7 per cent, and that of the other provinces, combined, the remaining 2.5 per cent.

Table I, which follows, presents the various items of production, by quantity and value, in the years 1938 to 1940, while in Table II will be found the principal statistics of the Industry from 1921 to 1940.

(a) The raw fur production statistics for the 12 months ended June 30, 1940, estimated that the value of pelts sold from fur farms would represent 31 per cent of the total value of all pelts produced in the period mentioned.

FOREIGN TRADE

Exports. - The total value of furs exported from Canada in the calendar year 1940 was \$16,176,075, this amount comprising: fur skins, undressed \$15,617,244; fur skins dressed, \$316,866; and manufactures of furs, \$241,965. Among the different kinds of raw furs, the items of chief importance, with regard to value, are: mink (\$3,877,559); Silver fox (\$2,816,693); muskrat (\$2,444,213); and beaver (\$2,025,457). Compared with the preceding year the value of the exports of raw furs shows an increase of \$1,487,056, or 11 per cent; dressed furs an increase of \$75,384, or 31 per cent; and manufactures of furs, an increase of \$44,649, or 23 per cent. The increase in the value of all furs exported was \$1,607,089.

Imports. - The imports of furs and fur goods in 1940 were valued at \$8,885,540 with raw furs accounting for \$6,896,806, or 77 per cent; dressed furs for \$1,766,726, or 20 per cent; and fur goods for \$222,008, or 3 per cent. The principal kinds of raw furs imported are: Persian lamb (\$1,672,156); muskrat (\$1,411,943); and rabbit (\$1,220,666). The total value of all furs imported shows an increase over the preceding year of \$1,752,488, or 25 per cent.

GENERAL TABLES

THE FUR DRESSING INDUSTRY, CANADA, 1940.

The fur dressing industry covers a total of 15 plants, of which 8 are located in the province of Quebec, 4 in Ontario and 3 in Manitoba. The industry has shown considerable advance during the past three years and records in 1940 a total of 9,021,302 skins treated, compared with 6,237,505 in 1939 and 4,197,079 in 1938. The work is established on a custom basis, that is, the customer sends the furs to be treated and is charged an amount per skin, which varies with the work performed. In 1940, the total amount received by the industry for the treatment of the furs was \$2,259,172, an increase over the preceding year of \$577,512, or 34 per cent, and an increase over 1938 of \$940,353, or 71 per cent. By provinces the amounts received are : Quebec, \$1,730,303; Ontario, \$383,399; and Manitoba, \$145,470.

The chief kinds of furs, with regard to number treated, in each of the three years are rabbit and muskrat, while third on the list in 1940 is opossum, and fourth, squirrel.

The principal statistics of the fur dressing industry in the years 1938 to 1940 are presented in the following table, while in table 2 are given, for the same years, the numbers of the various kinds of furs treated.
