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THE HAT AND CAP INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1931.

One hundred and forty-four establishments chiefly engaged in the manufacture of hats and caps reported their operations for 1931, being a decrease of nine from the number reporting the preceding year. There was a gross value of production of \$12,037,652, a decrease of \$2,187,137 or 15.4 per cent from the year 1930. The amount of capital investment, \$6,935,142, also shows a decline of \$338,945 or 4.7 per cent. Employment was furnished to 3,679 persons who were paid \$3,642,713 in salaries and wages, and in comparison with 1930 represented decreases of 528 or 12.6 per cent in the number of persons and \$595,592 or 14.1 per cent in the amount of salaries and wages. The cost of raw materials, \$6,107,297, fell to the extent of \$555,334 or 8.3 per cent, while the value added by manufacture showed a decline of \$1,631,803 or 21.6 per cent. The following table illustrates by provinces the variations in the principal statistics in 1931 in comparison with 1930.

Of the hundred and forty-four establishments reporting in 1931, sixty-five were located in Ontario, sixty-one in Quebec, eight in Manitoba, three each in New Brunswick, Alberta and British Columbia and one in Nova Scotia. Statistics published in this report must not be considered as comprehensive as regards hats and caps as they are also produced to some extent in the Men's Furnishing Goods and the Fur Industries.

In this industry the value of production in 1931 was \$12,037,652, and of this amount no less than \$11,491,029 was accounted for by the manufacture for sale of various sorts of headwear, including hat linings.

The production of 158,167 dozen of women's straw hats valued at \$2,872,665 headed the list, followed by 152,515 dozen of women's wool felt hats valued at \$2,184,414. Next came men's cloth caps, 192,922 dozen worth \$1,676,681, followed by men's fur felt hats, 54,224 dozen with a value of \$1,525,032. These various items are shown in detail in table 4, and in the majority of cases opportunity is afforded for a comparison with the output for the previous year.

Shapes and hoods of straw, velour, fur and wool felt comprised the principal items of raw materials used in this industry in 1931, and their collective cost was \$2,504,091. Fabrics of wool, cotton, silk, artificial silk, velvet, etc., were valued at \$1,189,763. As detailed statistics covering materials had not been collected for several years previous to 1931, it is impossible to make a comparison between 1930 and 1931.

Imports of raw and partly manufactured materials and finished headwear were valued at \$3,195,299 in 1931 against a valuation of \$4,241,539 in 1930. The only exports consisted of hats, and caps and their value was \$40,834 in 1931 and \$82,106 in 1930.
