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THE HAT AND CAP INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1939.

In 1939 reports were received from 156 establishments whose principal output consisted of hats and caps and hat and cap maker's materials. These establishments had a production valued at \$12,975,827, they employed 4,762 persons, paid out in salaries and wages the sum of \$4,487,446 and expended \$6,092,581 for materials. Capital invested amounted to \$7,546,844.

The hat and cap industry is mainly centered in Quebec and Ontario. Quebec, with 69 establishments in 1939 accounted for 43 per cent of the capital invested, 48 per cent of the persons employed, 48 per cent of the salaries and wages paid and 47 per cent of the gross value of production. Ontario with 65 establishments in the same year, reported 45 per cent of the capital, 42 per cent of the persons given employment, 44 per cent of the amount paid out in salaries and wages and 44 per cent of the gross value of all production in the industry.

A general improvement throughout the hat and cap industry occurred during 1939. The gross value of production increased by \$388,625 or 3 per cent, 256 more persons were given employment, an increase of 6 per cent, and the payroll also expanded to the extent of \$104,812 or 2 per cent. The cost of materials increased by \$155,566 or 3 per cent. Capital invested increased by \$998,160 or 15 per cent, the increase being due chiefly to a larger inventory value of materials, stocks in process, finished products, etc. on hand.

In the hat and cap industry as a whole "men's fur felt hats" with a value of \$2,193,239 was the most important item of production in 1939. This was followed by "women's wool felt hats" with \$2,100,824, "hat bodies in the rough" \$1,917,971, "women's straw hats" \$1,672,372, "cloth caps" \$1,162,141, and "women's fur felt hats" \$1,126,098. These items represented approximately 78 per cent of the total production for the industry.

Statistics covering materials used in the industry are not collected in detail. Therefore, only the total cost is shown.

Of the 3,932 wage-earners employed by the hat and cap industry in 1939, males numbered 1,930 and females 2,002. Maximum employment was reached in April with 4,390 employed while the minimum number was 3,382 in December.

THE HAT AND CAP INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1939.

The imports of raw materials, partly manufactured and fully manufactured hats and caps during the year 1939 were valued at \$2,604,643 or \$290,348 more than in 1938. Fully manufactured headwear of all kinds accounted for \$580,309 of this total.

Hats and caps exported during 1939 were valued at \$220,816 or \$10,597 less than in 1938.
