

THE HAT AND CAP INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1945.

In 1945 reports were received from 164 establishments whose principal output consisted of hats, caps and hat and cap maker's materials. These establishments had a production valued at \$23,229,066, they employed 5,220 persons, paid out in salaries and wages the sum of \$7,361,703 and expended \$11,405,927 for materials.

The hat and cap industry is mainly centered in Quebec and Ontario. Quebec, with 73 establishments in 1945 accounted for 50 per cent of the persons employed, 48 per cent of the salaries and wages paid and about 47 per cent of the gross value of production. Ontario with 71 establishments in the same year, reported 42 per cent of the persons given employment, over 45 per cent of the amount paid out in salaries and wages and over 46 per cent of the gross value of all production in the industry.

The industry operated at a slightly higher level in 1945. The gross value of production increased by \$1,561,784 or 7.2 per cent, while the physical volume of production was only 1.2 per cent higher. The greater increase in the value as compared with the volume is due to increased selling values of the products made. Indicative of the increased output is an increase of 97 or 1.9 per cent in the number of persons employed. The value added by manufacture was \$915,434 higher, of which amount \$412,277 was passed along in increased salary and wage payments. Both the annual and weekly earnings were higher than in the previous year.

In the hat and cap industry as a whole "men's fur felt hats" with a value of \$4,740,806 was the most important item of production in 1945. This was followed by "women's wool felt hats" with \$4,243,112, "women's fur felt hats", \$2,218,301, "women's straw hats", \$2,157,116 and "cloth caps", \$1,848,756. These items represented over 63 per cent of the total production for the industry. For details of production see Table 4.

Statistics covering materials used in the industry are not collected in detail. Therefore, only the total cost is shown.

Of the 4,342 wage-earners employed by the hat and cap industry in 1945, males numbered 1,752 and females 2,590. Maximum employment was reached in October with 4,510 employed while the minimum number was 3,997 in June. The proportion of female wage-earners working in this industry increased as a result of the war, the percentage advancing from 50 in 1939 to 60 in 1945.
