## HAT AND CAP INDUSTRY

### 1949

In 1949 reports were received from 163 establishments whose principal output consisted of hats, caps and hat and cap makers' materials. These establishments had a production valued at \$26,244,201. They employed 4,760 persons, paid out in salaries and wages the sum of \$9,004,917, and expended \$11,268,684 for materials.

The Hat and Cap Industry is mainly centered in Quebec and Ontario. Quebec, with 73 establishments in 1949, accounted for 47 per cent of the persons employed, 46 per cent of the salaries and wages paid and 47 per cent of the gross value of production. Ontario, with 70 establishments in the same year, reported 43 per cent of the persons given employment, 45 per cent of the amount paid out in salaries and wages and 45 per cent of the gross value of all production in the industry.

The industry operated at a level somewhat higher than that of 1948. The gross value of production increased by \$1,288,840 or 5.2 per cent. Employment was provided for 46 or 1 per cent more persons, which increase in employment was accompanied by an increase in salary and wage payments amounting to \$646,046 or 7.7 per cent. The amount expended for materials was higher by \$126,139, an increase of 1.1 per cent, and the value added by manufacture increased by \$1,151,978.

In the Hat and Cap Industry as a whole "men's fur felt hats" with a value of \$5,874,429 was the most important item of production in 1949. This was followed by "women's wool felt hats" with \$4,176,932, "women's straw hats", \$3,814,571, "women's fur felt hats", \$3,012,932, and "cloth caps", \$1,653,824. These items represented over 70 per cent of the total production for the industry. For details of production see Table 4.

Statistics covering materials used in the industry are not collected in detail. Therefore, only the total cost is shown.

Of the 4,037 wage-earners employed by the Hat and Cap Industry in 1949, males numbered 1,714 and females 2,323. Maximum employment was reached in March with 4,141 employed while the minimum number was 3,824 in December.


