


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THE HAT AND CAP INDUSTRY

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NOTICE

THE HAT AND CAP INDUSTRY

1954

The statistics of this report indicate a somewhat lower level of operations for the hat and cap industry in 1954 as compared with 1953. Factory shipments in the year under review had a value f.o.b. plant of \$28,271,272, down 4.6 per cent from the earlier year's \$29,631,952. The number of employees declined by 4.5 per cent, 4,708 in 1954 as against 4,928 in 1953, and their earnings by 2.4 per cent, \$10,789,884 compared with \$11,057,900. Material costs were reduced from \$11,741,210 in 1953 to \$11,305,582 in 1954, a drop of 3.7 per cent.

Three of the four sections into which the industry is divided reported diminished deliveries. The largest section, "women's and children's hats", recorded a reduction in the value of products shipped from \$15,221,459 in 1953 to \$14,523,210 in 1954. Shipments of the "men's hats" section fell from \$6,841,638 to \$5,978,042 and those of the "hat and cap makers' materials" section from \$2,090,556 to \$2,076,668 over the two years. Only the "caps" section resisted the downward trend. The value of products shipped by this section increased in value from \$5,478,299 in the earlier year to \$5,693,352 in the later. The change in the relative importance of the four sections is shown by a comparison of the percentages of total shipments each was responsible for in 1953 and 1954. These, with 1953 figures in brackets, are as follows; women's and children's hats 51(51); men's hats, 21(23); caps, 20(19); hat and cap maker's materials, 8(7).

Women's straw hats replaced men's fur felt hats as the industry's most important commodity, a position held continuously by the displaced product since 1943. The change resulted from a substantial reduction in the volume of men's fur felts and not from an increase in women's straws which were also shipped in reduced quantities, 130,774 dozen worth \$5,027,806 in 1954 compared with 137,547 dozen worth \$5,180,098 in 1953. Deliveries of men's fur felt hats dropped to 88,317 dozen worth \$4,462,010 in the later year from 103,377 dozen worth \$5,298,591 in the earlier. Shipments of other main commodities in order of importance were: cloth caps, 237,157 dozen valued at \$2,581,623; women's velour hats, 44,153 dozen at \$2,238,441; women's wool felt hats, 75,655 dozen at \$2,009,302; and women's fur felt hats, 29,221 dozen at \$1,556,069. Full detail of products shipped will be found in Table 5 of this report.

The 169 establishments were distributed provincially as follows; Nova Scotia 3, New Brunswick 1, Quebec 80, Ontario 68, Manitoba 13, Alberta 3 and British Columbia 1. As indicated by the number of establishments, Quebec and Ontario dominated the industry. Quebec accounted for 49 per cent of shipments and 50 per cent of employment; Ontario for 41 per cent of shipments and 38 per cent of employment.

The hat and cap industry is comprised of establishments which vary considerably in size. From Table 11 it will be seen that the sizes range from 33 firms with shipments of under \$25,000 to 3 firms with shipments in excess of \$1,000,000. Out of a total of 169 establishments, 79 reported shipments varying between \$50,000 and \$200,000.

Imports of materials used and products made by the hat and cap industry fell from \$5,983,175 in 1953 to \$5,281,086 in 1954. Exports showed an increase from \$180,952 to \$210,614 over the same period. For full details of imports and exports reference should be made to Tables 7 and 8 of this report.

Beginning with 1954 information on the value of year-end inventory holdings at plant and plant warehouses is being collected as part of the annual Census of Industry. This data was formerly collected by a separate survey. The summarized results for the hat and cap industry for the year under review will be found in Table 3.
