In terms of both the revised Standard Industrial Classification and the New Establishment Concept, this industry is defined as comprising those "Establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing hats of straw, cloth, fur felt and wool felt; hat and cap materials and millinery".

No detailed information is collected on manufacturing materials and supplies used by this industry so that Table 12 presents these data with a minimum of breakdown. The shipments by the industry proper of goods of own manufacture are shown in as much detail as possible in Table 13.

A list of the establishments classified to the industry in the 1966 survey will be found at the end of this report.

NOTE

The detailed "Concepts and Definitions" notes, usually carried each year, have been omitted from this 1966 report for reasons of economy. Reference to these notes may be had by consulting any 1965 report in this series. Failing this, a copy may be obtained free of charge upon application to the Manufacturing and Primary Industries Division of the Bureau.
