MEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1925

Ottawa, February 1927. A report on men's ready-to-wear clothing made in factories in Canada during the calendar year 1925 is presented herewith. Reports were received from 175 establishments in 16 of which the clothing was made by outside contractors from materials furnished by the firm reporting, - in consequence of which the number of employees, wages paid and the number of days the factories were in operation were omitted. A comparative summary for the years 1924 and 1925 showing the location of the factories by provinces is given in the following table:

In order not to divulge information concerning individual establishments statistics for New Brunswick and Nova Scotia have been combined and are shown throughout this report under the head of Maritime provinces. Similar procedure has been adopted in the case of Alberta and British Columbia which are shown as Western Provinces.

Production

The total value of all articles of clothing manufactured during the calendar year 1925 is shown by provinces in table 2. The total amount in 1924 was \$36,403,293, whilst the amount reported for 1925 was \$38,236,384, an increase of \$1,833,091.

In order of importance the province of Quebec leads with a total output valued at \$23,218,979, - Ontario follows next with \$14,037,515, - the Western provinces take third place with \$448,717, the Maritime provinces occupy fourth position with \$365,884 and Manitoba last with \$165,289.

Capital Investment

The amount of capital invested in the industry is given by provinces in table 3 for the calendar year 1925. The total capitalization rose from \$22,976,062 in 1924 to \$24,180,348 in 1925, an increase of \$1,204,286. The province of Quebec again takes precedence with a total investment of \$15,981,021, Ontario ranks second in importance with \$7,707,767, whilst Western provinces, Maritime provinces and Manitoba follow in the order named.

Employees, Salaries and Wages

The number of persons employed in the industry during the calendar years 1924 and 1925 is given in table 4, by (a) classes of employment, (b) sex and (c) salary and wage payments.

The total number of persons on the payroll during the year 1924 was 11,214 whose united earnings amounted to \$11,484,914, whilst for the period covered by this report the total was 11,109 with a total payment of \$11,798,063 - being a decrease of 105 in the number of persons employed and an increase of \$313,149 in salary and wage-payments. In addition to this amount the sum of \$623,751 was paid to contractors but the number of persons they employed was not reported.

Employment Statistics

The number of days the factories were in operation during the calendar years 1924 and 1925 together with the number of hours per day and per week normally worked by wage-earners is given in table 5. The total number of wage-earners employed during the same period is given by sex and by months in table 6. Employment reached its maximum in August with 9,797, whilst the minimum number reported was 8,950 in the month of December.

Fuel Consumption

The quantity and value of the various kinds of fuel consumed in the industry during the calendar years 1924 and 1925 is given in table 7. The total expenditure for all fuel rose from \$75,716 in 1924 to \$86,331 in 1925, an increase of \$10,615. Coal takes precedence over all other fuel with a total cost of \$64,026, gas takes second place with \$10,820, whilst fuel oil occupies third position with \$9,011.

Power Installation

The power installation of the industry in the year 1925 is shown in table 8 by (a) classes of power, (b) number of units in each class and (c) the horse power capacity according to the manufacturers rating. In 1924 the power installed was reported at 400 units with a development of 1,873 horse power, whilst for the period covered by this report the number of units was 372 with a capacity of 1,692 horse power, a decrease of 28 units and 181 horse power over the two year period.

Materials Used

The total cost of all materials used in the manufacture of ready-to-wear clothing is shown by provinces in table 9 for the calendar years 1924 and 1925. The total cost rose from \$18,245,874 in 1924 to \$19,890,260 in 1925, an increase of \$1,644,386.
