

MEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1926

Ottawa, February 1928. A report on men's ready-to-wear clothing made in factories in Canada during the calendar year 1926 is presented herewith. Reports were received from 188 establishments in 20 of which the clothing was made by outside contractors from materials furnished by the firm reporting, - in consequence of which the number of employees, wages paid and the number of days the factories were in operation were omitted. A comparative summary for the years 1925 and 1926 showing the location of the factories by provinces is given in the following table:

In order that no information may be divulged concerning individual establishments, statistics for New Brunswick and Nova Scotia have been combined and are shown throughout this report under the head of Maritime Provinces. Similar procedure has been adopted in the case of Alberta and British Columbia which are shown under the head of Western Provinces.



MEN'S FACTORY SLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1926

A threefold measure of the size of establishments is presented in the following series of tables. Table (a) affords a measure of establishments from the standpoint of employment, table (b) from the amount of Capital investment and table (c) the gross value of production.

From a study of these tables it will be noted that 32 establishments in a total of 175 employed 63.10 per cent of the total number at work in 1925 as compared with 29 establishments in a total of 188 employing 59.51 per cent in 1926. Similarly in capital investment 32 establishments had 68.73 per cent of the total investment in 1925 whilst in 33 establishments in 1926 the percentage to the total capital was 70.29. Again in gross value of production 50 establishments in 1925 produced 74.02 per cent of the total, whereas in 1926 for the same number of establishments the percentage was 72.78 of the total gross value of production.





Production

The total value of all articles of clothing manufactured during the calendar year 1926 is shown by provinces in table 2. The total amount in 1925 was \$38,236,384, whilst the amount reported for 1926 was \$41,784,131, an increase of \$3,547,747.


In order of importance the province of Quebec leads with a total output-valued at \$25,664,154, - Ontario follows next with \$14,943,320, - Western provinces take third place with \$504,028, the Maritime provinces occupy fourth position with \$472,120 and Manitoba last with \$200,509.

Capital Investment

The amount of capital invested in the industry is given by provinces in table 3 for the calendar year 1926. The total capitalization rose from \$24,180,348 in 1925 to \$25,826,383 in 1926, an increase of \$1,646,035. The province of Quebec again takes precedence with a total investment of \$16,503,106. Ontario ranks second in importance with \$8,727,629, whilst Western Provinces, Maritime Provinces and Manitoba follow in the order named.

Employees, Salaries and Wages

The number of persons employed in the industry during the calendar years 1925 and 1926 is given in table 4, by (a) classes of employment, (b) sex and (c) salary and wage payments. The number of persons employed in 1925 was 11,109 with \$8,727,629 in total investment of which Quebec again takes precedence with a total investment of \$16,503,106. The province of Quebec again takes precedence with a total investment of \$16,503,106 in 1926. The total number of persons on the payroll during the year 1925 was 11,109 whose united earnings amounted to \$11,798,063, whilst for the period covered by this report the total was 11,363 with a total payment of \$12,660,325 being an increase of 254 in the number of persons employed and an increase of \$862,262 in salary and wage payments. In addition to this amount the sum of \$796,028 was paid to contractors but the number of persons they employed was not reported.

The number of persons employed during the period covered by this report the total was 11,363 with a total payment of \$12,660,325 being an increase of 254 in the number of persons employed and an increase of \$862,262 in salary and wage payments. In addition to this amount the sum of \$796,028 was paid to contractors but the number of persons they employed was not reported.

Employment Statistics

The number of days the factories exclusive of contractors, were in operation during the calendar years 1925 and 1926 together with the number of hours per day and per week normally worked by wage-earners is given in table 5. The total number of wage-earners employed during the same period is given by sex and by months in table 6. Employment reached its maximum in October with 10,294, whilst the minimum number reported was 8,889 in the month of January.



Fuel Consumption

The quantity and value of the various kinds of fuel consumed in the industry during the calendar years 1925 and 1926 is given in table 7. The total expenditure for all fuel rose from \$86,331 in 1925 to \$102,235 in 1926, an increase of \$15,904. Coal takes precedence over all other fuel with a total cost of \$73,014, gas takes second place with \$14,901, whilst fuel oil occupies third position with \$10,865. The cost of electricity purchased in 1926 was \$63,290 as compared with \$59,210 in 1925.

Power Installation

The power installation of the industry in the year 1926 is shown in table 8 by (a) classes of power, (b) number of units in each class and (c) the horse power capacity according to the manufacturers rating. In 1925 the power installed was reported at 372 units with a development of 1,692 horse power, whilst for the period covered by this report the number of units was 394 with a capacity of 1,902 horse power, an increase of 22 units and 210 horse power over the two year period. The number of boilers installed in 1926 was 86 with a boiler h.p. capacity of 932.

Materials Used

The total cost of all materials used in the manufacture of ready-to-wear clothing is shown by provinces in table 9 for the calendar years 1925 and 1926. The total cost rose from \$19,890,260 in 1925 to \$21,944,919 in 1926, an increase during the year of \$2,054,659.






