



SECTION I

**THE MEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1939.**

There was considerable variation in the production of men's clothing during the sixteen-year period, 1924-39. From 1924 to 1929 a steady advance in the value of production and salary and wage payments was recorded. Commencing with 1930, however, marked decreases occurred which continued until 1932. During the next five years increases in the value of production were reported each year. In 1938 there was another slight recession. With the recovery in 1939, the amount of capital invested, the number of persons given employment, and the salaries and wages paid reached an all-time high. Due to the decline in the prices of clothing, the value of production was still 13 per cent below the peak year of 1929. The volume of men's clothing produced, however, was almost as high if not slightly higher.

In 1939 there were 375 establishments engaged in the production of men's clothing. This is exclusive of clothing contractors who are reviewed in Section II. These plants reported a capital investment in fixed and current assets of \$40,791,892. They furnished employment to 22,426 persons who received \$20,068,061 in salaries and wages. They also paid out \$39,991,597 for raw materials and produced goods that had a selling value at the factory of \$70,807,930.

In the men's factory clothing industry there are eight more or less distinct divisions as regards the nature of the products manufactured. These divisions are not, however, all inclusive and a certain amount of overlapping occurs. The classification of an establishment is, therefore, determined by its principal products. For example, a firm whose production is composed of \$100,000 worth of suits and overcoats, and \$35,000 worth of overalls and work shirts is placed in the "suits and overcoats" section; whereas a firm producing \$25,000 worth of fine shirts and \$10,000 worth of men's neckwear would be placed in the "fine shirts" section. These divisions together with the number of persons they employ and the value of products manufactured in 1939 are given in the table following:

NOTE - The statistics published in this report include only those manufacturers whose principal item of production is men's factory clothing. Statistics relating to these specific products, however, are not to be regarded as representing the total Canadian production as they are also included to some extent in the Women's Factory Clothing and other industries. For the total Canadian production reference should be made to the "Alphabetical List of Products Manufactured in Canada" which is shown as an appendix to all annual reports on the "Manufacturing Industries of Canada".

NOTE - Statistics covering materials used are not collected in detail. The total cost is shown by provinces in Table 1 and by industry in Table 4.

THE MEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1939.

SECTION II. - CLOTHING CONTRACTORS, 1939

In this branch of the clothing industry, which embraces both men's and women's clothing manufactured under contract, reports were received from 133 establishments of which 105 were located in the Province of Quebec, mostly in the city of Montreal, and 28 in Ontario with Toronto being the principal centre of activity. The total value of work performed during 1939 was \$2,142,961 which represents an increase of \$144,107 over the amount reported for the previous year.

The materials used, which are supplied by the contractors themselves, consisting principally of thread, buttons, etc., amounted to \$203,730 in 1939. Tables 14 to 21 inclusive, cover the principal statistics - capital investment, salaries and wages, employment, hours of work, power installation and consumption of fuel and electricity. A list of the 133 contractors is given in Appendix 2.
