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SECTION I

THE MEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1945

In 1945 there were 453 establishments operating in this industry. These plants furnished employment to 27,423 persons who received \$36,933,900 in salaries and wages, and produced goods with a selling value at the factory of \$139,920,218.

In comparing the 1945 operations with that of the previous year, it is found that there was an increase of \$1,863,463 or 1.4 per cent in the gross value of production, while the physical volume of production was about 6.2 per cent lower. There was also an increase of 407 or 1.5 per cent in the number of persons employed and \$1,566,-366 or 4.4 per cent in the amount of salaries and wages paid. Weekly earnings of male wage-earners advanced from \$33.47 in 1944 to \$35.12 in 1945, while earnings of female workers advanced from \$17.81 to \$18.13.

Nineteen forty-two was the banner year for the industry both as regards the physical volume of production and the number of persons employed. In spite of the declines during the past two years, the number of employees and physical volume of production were still 22 and 36 per cent higher than in 1939.

In the men's factory clothing industry there are eight more or less distinct divisions as regards the nature of the products manufactured. These divisions are not, however, all inclusive and a certain amount of overlapping occurs. The classification of an establishment is, therefore, determined by its principal products. For example, a firm whose production is composed of \$100,000 worth of suits and overcoats, and \$35,000 worth of overalls and work shirts is placed in the "suits and overcoats" section; whereas a firm producing \$25,000 worth of fine shirts and \$10,000 worth of men's neckwear would be placed in the "fine shirts" section. These divisions together with the number of persons employed and the value of products manufactured in 1945 are given in the table following: -

SECTION II. - CLOTHING CONTRACTORS, MEN'S, 1945

In this branch of the clothing industry, reports were received from 128 establishments of which 109 were located in the Province of Quebec, mostly in the city of Montreal, which is the centre of the industry. There were also 19 establishments in Ontario, 14 of which were located in the city of Toronto. The total value of work performed during 1945 was \$5,050,732 whilst the number of persons employed was 3,470 who received \$4,021,615 in salaries and wages.

The materials used, which are supplied by the contractors themselves, consisting principally of thread, buttons, etc., amounted to \$235,835 in 1945. Tables 13 to 20 inclusive, cover the principal statistics - capital **investment**, salaries and wages, employment, hours of work, power installation and consumption of fuel and electricity.
