THE MEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY

SECTION I. MEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING, 1952

Commencing with 1952, the value of factory shipments f.o.b. plant has been collected in place of gross value of production for the men's factory clothing industry. The value of shipments was substituted for value of production in all industries where inventory change was known to be insignificant and where, therefore, factory shipments approximate production. However, they will not be exactly comparable and this fact must be kept in mind when comparisons are made with earlier years. The changeover is expected to provide increased ease in reporting for the majority of plants while at the same time producing more reliable, more meaningful statistics in many cases.

The factory selling value of the products shipped by the men's factory clothing industry in 1952 amounted to \$277,426,014. Since what little change there was in finished goods inventory was upwards—an estimated \$155,000—gross value of production was at least the equal of the value of shipments. It was, then, the highest on record, exceeding the previous high of \$238,661,331 established in 1951. That the industry operated at its peak is evident from the fact that its activity was highest as well in all other terms; number of establishments, number of employees, salaries and wages paid, and cost of materials consumed. The year 1952 was indeed a banner year for the industry during which it demonstrated its ability to continue its expansion of the past few years.

The industry's operations expanded substantially in 1952. The upswing was first noticeable in February and was no doubt due to the need to replenish inventories at both retail and factory levels. Continuing improvement accompanied the expansion of clothing sales at retail level from April onwards. A comparison of the statistics of the 1951 and 1952 operations serves to show the growth of the industry's activities in the year under review. To begin with, there were 10 more establishments in 1952. The data given in the preceding paragraph indicates an increase in value of output approximating 14 per cent. Employment which stood at 32,732 in 1951

rose to 35,583 in 1952, an increase of 8 per cent, while salaries and wage payments advanced by 14 per cent from \$62,316,166 to \$72,782,226 over the two years. The cost of materials used was higher by 13 per cent having increased from \$131,612,306 in 1952 to \$151,357,963 in 1952.

The men's factory industry in 1952 consisted of 587 establishments distributed provincially as follows: Newfoundland 2, Nova Scotia 7, New Brunswick 1, Quebec 347, Ontario 158, Manitoba 44, Saskatchewan 1, Alberta 9 and British Columbia 18. The industry was largely centred in the cities of Montreal and Toronto. Montreal accounted for 33 per cent of employment and 37 per cent of shipments; Toronto for 21 per cent of employment and 21 per cent of shipments.

The most important commodity produced by the industry is men's fine suits. Shipments of these in 1952 amounted to 1,584,174 having a value f.o.b. plant of \$55,376,296. Boys' suits were shipped to the extent of 228,539 suits valued at \$2,536,655. Shipments of men's overcoats and topcoats amounting to 934,957 coats with a value of \$27,327,644 ranked second in importance. Pants and slacks, fine, are one of the main products of the industry which in 1952 shipped 3,150,022 men's and 1,519,469 boys' valued at \$20,344,631 and \$4,515,147 respectively. Men's fine cotton shirts, another prime product, were shipped to the extent of 583,285 dozen worth \$17,303,114. Full details of products shipped will be found in Table 5A of this report.

Seven more or less distinct divisions comprise the industry and the principal statistics for these are given in Table 3. The "suits and coats" division which is by far the largest reported shipments valued at \$134,582,880 or practically half the total for the industry. The "overalls and work shirts" division ranked second with \$37,577,249. The seven divisions together with the number of persons employed and the value of goods shipped in 1952 are given in the table following:

SECTION II. CLOTHING CONTRACTORS, MEN'S, 1952

In 1952 reports were received from 141 establishments classified as men's clothing contractors. The gross value of work performed equalled \$8,783,073. There were 3,759 employees in the industry and salaries and wages amounted to \$6,551,920. The Province of Quebec dominated the industry accounting for 87 per cent of the establishments, 92 per cent of the gross value of work performed and 94 per cent of employment.

The 141 establishments in the industry were divided as follows: Quebec 123 and Ontario 18. In terms of cities, Montreal accounted for 90 es-

blishments, Toronto 17 and Joliette 5. Montreal accounted for \$5,008,349 or 57 per cent of the gross value of work performed and 1,891 employees or 50 per cent of the total employees.

The materials used, which are supplied by the contractors themselves, consisting principally of thread, buttons, etc. amounted to \$699,557 in 1952. The following tables give details of the industry, its location, principal statistics, provincial distribution of employees by sex and remuneration and stability of the industry as reflected in the monthly employment of wage-earners.
