

# THE MEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY

1953

## SECTION I. MEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING, 1953

For 1953 as a whole, activity in the men's factory clothing industry was slightly below 1952. The factory shipments made by the industry were valued at \$273,946,025 compared with \$277,426,014 a year earlier. Employment which stood at 35,583 in 1952 fell to 35,119 in 1953. More significant, still, than this overall reduction in employment was the fall in production workers from 31,257 to 30,696 with the difference resulting from a steadily increasing release of workers during the latter part of 1953.

The market situation at the beginning of 1953 gave promise of a record year for the men's factory clothing industry. Under the stimulus of increased personal incomes, expanding credit and slightly lower prices, consumer demand for the industry's products had increased substantially in 1952. This strong demand continued well into 1953 and in conjunction with a need to replenish retail, wholesale and factory inventories provided the impetus for a level of activity in the industry for the first half somewhat higher than that for the same period in 1952, the year of peak activity. Although consumer demand remained high throughout the balance of the year under review, a slackening in the industry's production rate occurred as supplies grew sufficiently plentiful. By December, inventories had accumulated at all levels and the industry's operations were considerably below those of December of the previous year.

The men's factory clothing industry has experienced uninterrupted expansion in the postwar period with new highs being established yearly. The curtailment of activity in 1953 came after a 10-year period of successive annual advances. The reversed trend in this year, however, should not be allowed to obscure the fact that the level of operations was the second highest on record.

Somewhat anomalous was the increase in establishments from 587 in 1952 to 601 in 1953. These were distributed provincially as follows: Newfoundland 1, Nova Scotia 7, New Brunswick 2, Quebec 350, Ontario 160, Manitoba 49, Alberta 9 and British Columbia 23. The industry was largely centred in the cities of Montreal and Toronto. Montreal accounted for 33 per cent of employment and 39 per cent of shipments; Toronto for 21 per cent of employment and 20 per cent of shipments.

A point of interest is the increase of over 5 per cent in the salaries and wages bill of 1953 over 1952. The earnings of employees rose from \$70,782,226 to \$74,709,888 over the two years despite a reduction in the numbers employed and in the absence of any extension in the length of the working week.

Seven more or less distinct divisions comprise the industry and the principal statistics for these are given in Table 3. The "suits and overcoats" division which is by far the largest reported shipments valued at \$127,297,868 or 46 per cent of industry total. The "overall and work shirts" division ranked second with \$40,153,962. The seven divisions together with the number of persons employed and value of good shipped in 1953 are given in the table at the bottom of this page.

The most important commodity produced by the industry is men's fine suits. Shipments of these in 1953 amounted to 1,825,640 having a value f.o.b. plant of \$63,953,064. Boys' suits were shipped to the extent of 158,333 suits valued at \$1,751,299. Shipments of men's overcoats and topcoats amounting to 851,078 coats with a value of \$24,288,410 ranked second in importance. Pants and slacks, fine, are one of the main products of the industry which in 1953 shipped 3,353,415 men's and 1,674,913 boys' valued at \$20,487,487 and \$4,846,242 respectively. Men's fine cotton shirts for dress or business, another prime product, were shipped to the extent of 631,342 dozen worth \$18,411,254. Full detail of products shipped will be found in Table 5A of this report.

Note on 1954—While the Census of Industry survey at the time of preparing this report is quite incomplete, data from other sources within the Bureau indicate a further reduction of activity in 1954 in the men's factory clothing industry. Based on a monthly sample survey, shipments were estimated to have fallen to \$255,028,000, a drop of 9 per cent from the 1953 figure. Employment was lower by 13 per cent according to a monthly survey of all firms with 15 or more employees. This curtailment of activity was associated with a decline of about 3 per cent in retail sales of men's clothing in 1954 together with a drawing down of the relatively heavy inventories which overhung the market at the beginning of the year.

Note. The classification of a firm is determined by its products of chief value. For example, a firm whose factory shipments comprise \$100,000 worth of suits and overcoats, and \$35,000 worth of overalls and work shirts is placed in the "Suits and overcoats" section, whereas a firm shipping \$25,000 worth of fine shirts and \$10,000 worth of men's neckwear would be placed in the "fine shirts" section.

## SECTION II. CLOTHING CONTRACTORS, MEN'S, 1953

In 1953 reports were received from 160 establishments classified as men's clothing contractors. The gross value of work performed equalled \$10,877,993. There were 4,484 employees in the industry and salaries and wages amounted to \$7,862,881. The Province of Quebec dominated the industry accounting for 88 per cent of the establishments, 92 per cent of the gross value of work performed and 95 per cent of employment.

The 160 establishments in the industry were divided as follows: Quebec 140 and Ontario 20. In terms of cities, Montreal accounted for 100 estab-

blishments, Toronto 18, Joliette 5 and Three Rivers 4. Montreal accounted for \$5,646,469 or 52 per cent of the gross value of work performed and 2,054 employees or 46 per cent of the total employees.

The materials used, which are supplied by the contractors themselves, consisting principally of thread, buttons, etc. amounted to \$870,477 in 1953. The following tables give details of the industry, its location, principal statistics, provincial distribution of employees by sex and remuneration and stability of the industry as reflected in the monthly employment of wage-earners.
