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

THE MEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY

1955

SECTION I. MEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING, 1955

Shipments from establishments classified to the men's factory industry were valued at \$250,462,315 in 1955. This figure represents an increase of 4.2 per cent over the \$240,390,285 worth of goods shipped a year earlier. Since the industry's holding of finished goods inventory at plant and plant warehouses increased by \$1,717,120 during the year, the value of production in the year under review amounted to \$252,179,435 or 5.2 per cent more than the preceding year's \$239,739,830.

This increased production was achieved with fewer employees, 31,445 in 1955 as against 31,886 in 1954. Salary and wage payments, however, advanced to \$68,809,295 in the later year from \$67,578,714 in the earlier. Material costs increased from \$132,032,166 in 1954 to \$137,857,666 in 1955, a rise of 4.4 per cent.

The industry was comprised of 570 establishments, 12 less than the year before. These were located provincially as follows: Newfoundland 2, Nova Scotia 7, New Brunswick 2, Quebec 326, Ontario 152, Manitoba 49, Saskatchewan 1, Alberta 9 and British Columbia 22. A heavy concentration of establishments occurs in Montreal and Toronto, the industry's main centres. In 1955 Montreal accounted for 32 per cent of employment and 40 per cent of shipments; Toronto for 22 per cent of employment and 20 per cent of shipments.

The men's factory clothing industry is divided along commodity lines into seven more or less distinct sections. Principal statistics for these are compiled in Table 4 with Table 5 showing a breakdown by cities. Six of the seven sections recorded an increase over 1954 in the value of factory shipments. The largest absolute gain was reported by the fine shirts section with an increase from \$38,392,672 in 1954 to \$41,765,580 in the year under review. The greatest gain percentagewise was made by the trousers and separate garments section with shipments up 14 per cent from \$17,791,490 to \$20,280,134. The suits and coats section, which is by far the largest, reported a very slight increase from \$107,347,017 to \$107,804,742. The value of factory shipments for the other three sections which advanced, with 1954 figures in brackets, are as follows: overalls and work shirts

\$36,461,921 (\$34,424,520); windbreakers and work pants, \$30,917,659 (\$29,300,880); other men's wear \$6,072,220 (\$5,922,928). The men's neckwear section was the only one to report a decline and this was negligible, shipments being \$7,160,059 in 1955 compared with \$7,210,778 in 1954. Employment and value of shipments for the seven divisions in 1955 for Montreal, Toronto and Canada are given in the table at the bottom of this page.

A total of 1,709,358 men's suits worth \$57,587,302 were shipped by men's clothing manufacturers in 1955 compared with 1,643,134 worth \$57,560,105 in 1954. All wool suits account for a large part of these totals, the 1955 figures including 1,256,217 worth \$48,415,217. The number of boys' suits shipped increased slightly to 195,729 from 194,870 in the earlier year but the volume rise was accompanied by a fall in value to \$2,129,369 from \$2,218,724. Men's overcoats and topcoats were shipped to the extent of 741,502 coats with a value of \$20,950,945, up sharply over the 624,499 coats with a value of \$18,776,370 delivered in 1954. Shipments of pants and slacks, fine, totalled 3,262,242 men's and 1,567,040 boys' valued at \$19,030,839 and \$4,144,394, respectively. These figures represent a considerable increase over the previous year when 3,063,664 men's worth \$17,957,864 and 1,391,066 boys' worth \$3,673,688 were shipped. Men's fine cotton shirts for dress or business were shipped to the amount of 637,954 dozen worth \$18,802,253, somewhat higher than the year before when shipments of this commodity totalled 616,311 dozen worth \$17,848,496. Full detail of products shipped in 1955 and 1954 is to be found in Tables 6A and 6B, respectively, of this report.

Note on 1956 — While the Census of Industry survey at the time of preparing this report had only gotten underway, data from other sources within the Bureau indicate increased activity in 1956 in the men's factory clothing industry. Based on a monthly sample survey, shipments are estimated to have totalled \$272,281,000, a rise of 8.7 per cent over the 1955 figure. Man-hours worked increased by 6.4 per cent according to a monthly survey of all firms with 15 or more employees. This expansion in activity was associated with an increase of 7 per cent in retail sales of men's clothing in 1956.

Note. The classification of a firm is determined by its products of chief value. For example, a firm whose factory shipments comprise \$100,000 worth of suits and overcoats, and \$35,000 worth of overalls and work shirts is placed in the "suits and overcoats" section, whereas a firm shipping \$25,000 worth of fine shirts and \$10,000 worth of men's neckwear would be placed in the "fine shirts" section.

SECTION II. CLOTHING CONTRACTORS, MEN'S, 1955

The increased activity in this industry in 1955 was a reflection of the rise during the year in the level of operations of the men's factory clothing industry with which it is closely related. The gross value of work performed rose to \$11,597,592 from \$9,893,602 in 1954. Employment was provided for 4,663 persons compared with 4,124 persons a year earlier while salary and wage payments increased to \$8,297,903 from \$7,091,166.

In this industry the main material, fabrics, is supplied by the firms for which the clothing is being manufactured. The contractors themselves supply principally thread buttons, etc. In 1955 the

cost of the materials supplied by the contractors amounted to \$1,040,597 compared with \$871,017 in 1954.

The industry consisted of 153 establishments in 1955, one more than the year before. It was confined to Quebec and Ontario with 136 establishments in the first province and 17 establishments in the second. Quebec dominated the industry accounting for 94 per cent of the gross value of work performed and 95 per cent of employment. Montreal with 92 establishments was responsible for \$5,788,303 or 50 per cent of work performed and 1,990 employees or 43 per cent of the industry total.
