


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# THE MEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING INDUSTRY

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## NOTICE

## SECTION I. MEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING, 1956

Shipments from establishments classified to the men's factory industry were valued at \$272,145,915 in 1956. This figure represents an increase of 8.7 per cent over the \$250,462,315 worth of goods shipped a year earlier. Taking into account the changes during the year in inventories of goods in process and finished goods, the value of production amounted to \$275,397,020 or 9.2 per cent more than the preceding year's \$252,179,435.

The higher level of activity indicated by shipments and production was reflected in employment and material figures. The number of employees rose from 31,445 in 1955 to 32,041 in 1956 accompanied by a payroll increase from \$68,809,295 to \$75,171,943. Materials used in manufacture cost \$137,857,666 in 1955 and \$155,425,652 in 1956, an increase of 12.7 per cent.

The industry was comprised of 551 establishments, 19 less than the year before. These were located provincially as follows: Newfoundland 2, Nova Scotia 6, New Brunswick 1, Quebec 315, Ontario 143, Manitoba 53, Saskatchewan 1, Alberta 10 and British Columbia 20. A heavy concentration of establishments occurs in Montreal and Toronto, the industry's main centres. In 1956 Montreal accounted for 29 per cent of employment and 38 per cent of shipments; Toronto for 21 per cent of employment and 19 per cent of shipments.

The men's factory clothing industry is divided along commodity lines into seven more or less distinct sections. Principal statistics for these are compiled in Table 4 with Table 5 showing a breakdown by cities. All seven sections recorded an increase over 1955 in the value of factory shipments. The largest absolute gain was reported by the windbreakers and work pants section with an increase from \$30,917,659 in 1955 to \$38,049,862 in the year under review. This 23 per cent advance was also the largest gain percentagewise recorded by any of the sections. The suits and coats section, which is by far the largest, reported an increase from \$107,804,742 to \$113,763,390. The value of factory shipments for the other five sections, with 1955 figures in brackets, are as follows: fine shirts,

\$46,479,267 (\$41,765,580); overalls and work shirts, \$38,820,473 (\$36,461,921); trousers and separate garments, \$20,331,036 (\$20,280,134); neckwear, \$7,432,487 (\$7,160,059); other men's wear, \$7,269,400 (\$6,072,220). Employment and value of shipments for the seven divisions in 1956 for Montreal, Toronto and Canada are given in the table at the bottom of this page.

A total of 1,890,468 men's suits worth \$61,745,999 were shipped by men's clothing manufacturers in 1956 compared with 1,709,358 worth \$57,587,302 in 1955. All wool suits account for a large part of these totals, the 1956 figures including 1,433,225 worth \$51,801,514. The number of boys' suits shipped decreased to 192,230 from 195,729 in the earlier year but the volume fall was accompanied by a rise in value to \$2,159,619 from \$2,129,369. Men's overcoats and topcoats were shipped to the extent of 725,467 coats with a value of \$20,168,638, down somewhat from the 741,502 coats with a value of \$20,950,945 delivered in 1955. Shipments of pants and slacks, fine, totalled 3,287,649 men's and 2,020,426 boys' valued at \$19,888,687 and \$5,291,152, respectively. These figures compare with and so far as the boys' are concerned represent a considerable increase over the previous year when 3,262,242 men's worth \$19,030,839 and 1,567,040 boys' worth \$4,144,394 were shipped. Men's fine cotton shirts for dress or business were shipped to the amount of 632,980 dozen worth \$18,822,440 compared with the year before when shipments of this commodity totalled 637,954 dozen worth \$18,802,253. Full detail of products shipped in 1956 and 1955 is to be found in Tables 6A and 6B, respectively, of this report.

**Note on 1957** — While the Census of Industry survey at the time of preparing this report had only gotten underway, data from other sources within the Bureau indicate the level of activity in the men's factory clothing industry in 1957 was little changed from the previous year. Based on a monthly sample survey, shipments are estimated to have totalled \$280,997,000, a rise of 3.2 per cent over the 1956 figure. This manufacturing activity was associated with an increase of less than one per cent in retail sales of men's clothing in 1957.

For example, a firm whose factory shipments comprise \$100,000 worth of suits and overcoats, and \$35,000 worth of overalls and work shirts is placed in the "suits and overcoats" section, whereas a firm shipping \$25,000 worth of fine shirts and \$10,000 worth of men's neckwear would be placed in the "fine shirts" section.

## SECTION II. CLOTHING CONTRACTORS, MEN'S, 1956

The gross value of work performed by this industry in 1956 amounted to \$13,151,560, this being an increase of 13.4 per cent over the previous year's figure of \$11,597,592. The number of employees rose by 10.5 per cent to 5,151 in 1956 from 4663 in 1955 accompanied by a 13.6 per cent increase in salaries and wages paid to \$9,429,131 from \$8,297,903.

In this industry the main material, fabrics, is supplied by the firms for which the clothing is being manufactured. The contractors themselves supply principally thread, buttons, etc. In 1956

the cost of the materials supplied by the contractors amounted to \$1,468,665 compared with \$1,040,597 in 1955.

The industry in 1956 was comprised of 152 establishments of which 135 were in Quebec, 16 in Ontario and one in New Brunswick. There is naturally a concentration of contractors in Montreal where the greatest number of men's factory clothing establishments is to be found. The work performed by the contractors of this city amounted to \$6,151,658 or 47 per cent of total. They accounted for 40 per cent of the employees and 49 per cent of salary and wage payments of the industry.


