SECTION I. MEN'S FACTORY CLOTHING, 1957

Shipments from establishments classified to The Men's Factory Clothing Industry were valued at \$272,425,612 in 1957, a negligible increase over the \$272,145,915 worth of goods shipped a year earlier. Taking into account the changes during the year in inventories of goods in process and finished goods, the value of production amounted to \$274,675,082, again a negligible drop of 0.3 per cent from the preceding year's \$275,397,020.

This unchanged level of activity indicated by shipments and production was reflected in employment and material figures. The number of employees remained relatively constant from 32,041 in 1956 to 32,024 in 1957, but the payroll increased from \$75,171,943 to \$77,124,466. Materials used in manufacture cost \$155,425,652 in 1956 and \$152,560,645 in 1957, a decrease of 1.8 per cent.

The industry was comprised of 559 establishments, eight more than the year before. These were located provincially as follows: Newfoundland 2, Nova Scotia 6, New Brunswick 1, Quebec 315, Ontario 150, Manitoba 53, Saskatchewan 1, Alberta 10, and British Columbia 21. A heavy concentration of establishments occurs in Montreal and Toronto, the industry's main centres. In 1957, Montreal accounted for 29 per cent of employment and 38 per cent of shipments; Toronto for 22 per cent of employment and 19 per cent of shipments.

The Men's Factory Clothing Industry is divided along commodity lines into seven more or less distinct sections. Principal statistics for these are compiled in Table 4 with Table 5 showing a breakdown by cities. Only four sections recorded an increase over 1956 in the value of factory shipments. The largest absolute gain was reported by the trousers and separate garments section with an increase from \$20,331,036 in 1956 to \$23,170,382 in the year under review, a gain of 14 per cent. The largest percentage-wise gain recorded by any of the sections was in the other men's wear section with an increase of 25 per cent. The suits and overcoats section, which is by far the largest, reported a decrease from \$113,763,390 to \$108,017,155. The value of factory shipments for the other five sections, with 1956 figures in brackets, were as fol-

lows: fine shirts, \$48,301,687 (\$46,479,267); overalls and work shirts, \$37,215,013 (\$38,820,473); windbreakers and work pants, \$39,363,078 (\$38,049,862); neckwear, \$7,265,143 (\$7,432,487); other men's wear, \$9,093,154 (\$7,269,400). Employment and value of shipments for the seven divisions in 1957 for Montreal, Toronto and Canada are given in the table at the bottom of this page.

A total of 1,692,866 men's suits worth \$59,108,984 were shipped by men's clothing manufacturers in 1957 compared with 1,890,468 worth \$61,745,999 in 1956. All wool suits account for a large part of these totals, the 1957 figures including 1,294,666 worth \$50,811,786. The number of boys' suits shipped increased to 212,866 from 192,230 in the earlier year with a corresponding rise in value to \$2,272,156 from \$2,159,619. Men's overcoats and topcoats were shipped to the extent of 684,955 coats with a value of \$18,639,605 down sharply from the 725,467 coats with a value of \$20,168,638 delivered in 1956. Shipments of pants and slacks, fine, totalled 3,629,890 men's and 1,825,050 boys' valued at \$21,490,669 and \$5,184,662, respectively. A comparison with the comparable figures shows a considerable increase for men's wear since, in 1956, 3,287,649 men's worth \$19,888,687 and 2,020,426 boys' worth \$5,291,152 were shipped. Men's fine cotton shirts for dress or business were shipped to the amount of 672,265 dozen worth \$18,441,134, a numerical gain over the year before when shipments of this commodity totalled 632,980 dozen worth \$18,822,440. Full detail of products shipped in 1957 and 1956 is to be found in Tables 6A and 6B, respectively, of this report.

Note on 1958—While the 1958 Census of Industry survey at the time of preparing this report had just been started, data from other sources within the Bureau indicate the level of activity in the men's factory clothing industry in 1958 was little changed from the previous year. Based on a monthly sample survey, shipments are estimated to have totalled \$278,529,000 a drop of 3.2 per cent over the 1957 figures. This manufacturing activity was associated with an increase of less than one per cent in the retail sales of men's clothing in 1958.

SECTION II. CLOTHING CONTRACTORS, MEN'S, 1956

The gross value of work performed by this industry in 1957 amounted to \$13,244,032, a negligible increase over the previous year's total of \$13,151,560. The number of employees remained relatively constant from 5,151 in 1956 to 5,141 in 1957, but was accompanied by a 3.4 per cent increase in salaries and wages from \$9,429,131 to \$9,751,211.

In this industry the main material, fabrics, is supplied by the firms for which the clothing is being manufactured. The contractors themselves supply principally thread, buttons, etc. In 1957 the cost of

the materials supplied by the contractors amounted to \$1,383,156 compared with \$1,468,665 in 1956.

The industry in 1957 was comprised of 153 establishments of which 137 were in Quebec, 15 in Ontario and one in New Brunswick. There is naturally a concentration of contractors in Montreal where the greatest number of men's factory clothing establishments is to be found. The work performed by the contractors of this city amounted to \$6,805,003 or 51 per cent of total. They accounted for 44 per cent of the employees and 53 per cent of salary and wage payments of the industry.
